The Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES), Government of NCT of Delhi would be implementing the Summer Internship Programme for Graduate/Post-Graduate/Research Students of Statistics/Mathematical Statistics/Operational Research/Economics/Demography or any of the applied field of Statistics of recognized Universities/Institutions during 2026-27.

2. The broad fields/disciplines for internship include estimation of Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP); estimation of Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF); analysis of data pertaining to State Sample Surveys conducted under National Sample Survey (NSS) Rounds and other statistical surveys; analysis of price statistics and related indicators; analysis of data from the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI); analysis of statistics relating to registration of Births & Deaths and Medical Certification of Cause of Death (MCCD); analysis of statistics relating to Index of Industrial Production (IIP); analysis of statistical publications such as Statistical Abstract of Delhi, Gender Statistic; and analysis of data for monitoring Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); Index Numbers; and other areas relating to Official Statistics of the Government of NCT of Delhi.

3. The aim, scope, eligibility, duration, remuneration and procedure for selection etc. are given in the enclosed document.

4. Interested and eligible candidates may send their applications in the prescribed format to the Directorate of Economics & Statistics as per the details given in the enclosed document. The last date for submission of applications will be notified on the website of DES, GNCTD.

Subject: Invitation of Applications for Internship Programme in Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES), GNCTD.

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES), Government of NCT of Delhi proposes to implement a **Summer Internship Programme** for Graduate/Post-Graduate/Research Students of Statistics/Mathematical Statistics/Operational Research/Economics/Demography or any other applied field of Statistics from recognized Universities/Institutions.

The details of the scheme are as under:

1. Aim, Objective and Scope

- a) To facilitate students pursuing studies in statistics and allied fields to understand and familiarize themselves with the **official statistical system of Delhi**.
- b) To provide exposure to the processes of **data collection, compilation, processing, analysis and dissemination** of official statistics.
- c) To create awareness among students about the functioning of statistical systems in Government and the role of statistical analysis in public policy.
- d) To encourage students to consider career opportunities in the field of statistics and data analysis.

2. Number and Place of Internship

The number of Summer Internship Programme positions available during the year 2026-27 shall be **five (05)**.

The internships will be offered at the **Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Vikas Bhawan-II, Civil Lines, Delhi**.

The broad areas of internship are as follows:

9.	Planning	Statistical Abstract of Delhi; Gender Statistics.

3. Eligibility

Applicants should be **citizens of India** and pursuing **Graduate/Post-Graduate/Research programmes** in Statistics, Mathematical Statistics, Operational Research, Economics, Demography or any other applied field of Statistics from a recognized University/Institution.

4. Duration and Expected Output

The duration of the internship will be **two months from the date of joining**.

Each intern shall submit a **report/paper at the end of the internship**, highlighting the work undertaken, observations and suggestions, if any, for improvement in the system.

5. Remuneration

A consolidated **stipend of ₹10,000 (₹5,000 per month)** will be paid to each selected intern upon **successful completion of the internship through electronic mode of funds transfer/ Aadhaar Payments Bridge (APB)/ Aadhaar Enabled Payment System(AEPS)**.

If an intern discontinues the internship before completion of the prescribed period, he/she will **not be entitled to any stipend or certificate**.

A certificate will be issued to interns who successfully complete the internship.

The selected candidates shall report to the Directorate for joining. **No Travelling Allowance or Dearness Allowance** will be paid for joining the internship. Interns will have to make their own arrangements for **lodging, boarding and transportation**.

6. Facilities

DES will endeavor to provide basic logistic support to the interns, including office space, computer and internet facility subject to availability.

Interns may also be required to **bring their own laptops**, if necessary. Each intern will be attached to a **designated guide/nodal officer** for supervision and guidance during the internship.

7. Procedure for Application and Selection

- a) Applications for Summer Internship Programme shall be submitted in the prescribed format (**Annexure-I**) as per instructions given in **Annexure II**.
- b) The **last date for submission of applications is 31st May, 2026**.
- c) Selection of candidates will be based on academic performance, primarily the aggregate marks (excluding qualifying subject(s) obtained in higher secondary, graduation or post-graduation, as applicable.
- d) In case of CGPA, the applicant should indicate the conversion formula to percentage.
- e) The list of selected candidates will be displayed on the DES website and the candidates will also be informed through email. All the candidates are required to furnish their e-mail id **clearly and mandatorily** in the application form.
- f) Stipend will be transferred directly to the bank account of the intern through electronic mode of funds transfer/ Aadhar Payments Bridge (APB)/ Aadhar Enabled Payment System (AEPS) upon completion of the internship. **Selected candidates should submit their bank account details after joining the internship.**
- g) No enquiries regarding selection will be entertained other than through the designated officer.

1. Applicants desirous of applying for the Summer Internship Programme of the Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES), GNCTD shall submit their applications in the prescribed format.
2. The application form may be downloaded from the official website of DES, GNCTD.
3. The applicant shall fill the application form carefully with all required details.
4. After filling the application form, the applicant shall:
 - i. Take a printout of the duly filled application form.
 - ii. Affix a recent passport size coloured photograph in the space provided.
 - iii. Sign the declaration/undertaking given in the application form.
5. The photograph and No Objection Certificate (NOC) should be attested by the Head of the Institution/Department where the applicant is currently pursuing his/her studies.

7. The subject line of the email should clearly mention: “Application for Summer Internship Programme – DES, GNCTD (2026–27)”
8. The email should contain the following attachments:

 - iii. Self-attested copies of marks sheets of XII/Graduation/Post-Graduation (as applicable).
