#### **PREFACE**

The present report is on Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) 2012-2013 of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi, Thirty Second in the series, being issued by the Directorate of Economics & Statistics, is based on statistical returns furnished by the factories registered under Sections 2 m (i) & 2 m (ii) of the Factories Act, 1948.

It is for the second time when DES, Delhi participated in the field work of ASI 2012-13 on residual sample units. The report has been prepared by pooling unit level data provided by CSO (IS Wing), Govt. of India, having Census & Sample sector units and unit level data of 355 residual sample units surveyed by this Directorate. District level estimates for important characteristics have also been presented in the report for the second time.

The report provides a comprehensive data on characteristics of the industrial activity. The report also contains important characteristics relating to capital structure, capital formation, employment pattern, input, output, value added by manufacture etc. It also highlights the distribution of principal characteristics by the employment size, capital size and type of ownership/organisation and by size of capital. The report consists of two parts. The Part-I contains introduction, concepts and definitions and brief analysis of the industrial structure in the National Capital Territory, while Part-II is devoted to statistical tables.

The report has been prepared by Annual Survey of Industries Unit of the Directorate of Economics & Statistics under the guidance of Sh. C.K.Dutta, Deputy Director whereas Sh. R.K.Sharma Statistical Officer have supervised the work, Sh. Rakesh Kumar, Sh. Shahid, Sh. Rupender Singh Tomar, and Ms. Poonam Bansal Statistical Assistants have done compilation work.

The field work was conducted during the year 2013-14 under the able guidance of Dr. R.N. Sharma, Joint Director (now retired), Sh. Ravi Kant Sharma, Assistant Director (now retired), and Sh. Deepak kumar Statistical Officer (Presently Dy. Director in Planning Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi).

Data processing and tabulation work has been done in the EDP unit by Ms. Madhu, Assistant Programmer under the guidance of Shri. Praveen Srivastava, Programmer. Relative Standard Errors for Central/State/Pooled Samples are calculated by Mr. Hemant, Statistical Assistant under guidance of Sh. Praveen Srivastava. The strenuous efforts made by the officers and staff of ASI unit and EDP unit of this Directorate are highly appreciated.

The valuable co-operation, extended by the CSO (IS Wing), Kolkata of the Government of India by providing pre requisite data and guidance is acknowledged.

I hope the data published in this report will be useful to the Planners and Policy makers. Suggestions for improvement in the content of tables etc. in our future ASI reports are welcome.

#### CHAPTER – I

#### **INTRODUCTION**

The Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) is the principal source of industrial statistics in Delhi. It provides statistical information to assess and evaluate objectively and realistically the change in the growth, composition and structure of the organised manufacturing (Factory Sector), comprising activities associated with manufacturing processes, repair services, personal services, sanitary services, generation and transmission of electricity, gas, water supply and cold storages. Industrial sector occupies an important position in Delhi's economy and plays a pivotal role in the rapid and planned economic development.

Upto ASI 2010-11 the Annual Survey of Industries has so far been conducted annually under the statutory provisions of the collection of Statistical Act, 1953 and the rules framed there under in 1959. However, from ASI 2010-11 onwards, the survey is being conducted annually under the statutory provisions of the Collection of Statistics (COS) Act, 2008 and rules framed there-under in 2011. Upto ASI year 2010-11 the work of collection of Industrial Statistics from the organised industrial sector (Factory –Sector) has been entrusted to the Field Operations Division (FOD) of the National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO), Government of India. Under the arrangement, provision has been made for the supply of unit level data of ASI by the CSO (IS Wing), Kolkata to the Directorate of Economics & Statistics for use of State Government.

It is for the Second time when DES, Delhi participated in the field work of ASI 2012-13 on residual sample units. The report has been prepared by pooling unit level data provided by CSO (IS Wing), Govt. of India, having Census & Sample sector units and unit level data of 355 residual sample units surveyed by this Directorate.

#### **COVERAGE**

2. Coverage of the Annual Survey of Industries extends to the entire Factory Sector, comprising industrial units (called factories) registered under section 2(m)(i) and 2(m)(ii)

of the Factories Act.1948, wherein a "Factory", which is the primary statistical unit of enumeration for the ASI is defined as:-

"Any premises" including the precincts thereof:-

 wherein ten or more workers are working or were working on any day of the preceding twelve months, and in any part of which a manufacturing process is being carried on with the aid of power or is ordinarily so carried on,

or

(ii) wherein twenty or more workers are working or were working on any day of the preceding twelve months, and in any part of which a manufacturing process is being carried on without the aid of power or is ordinarily so carried on, but does not include a mine subject to the operation of the Mines Act, 1952, or a railway running shed.

The "manufacturing process" referred to above has been defined under section 2(k) of the Factories Act, 1948 as:-

"Any process" for-

- making, altering, ornamenting, finishing, packing, oiling, washing, cleaning, breaking up, demolishing or otherwise treating or adapting any article or substance with a view to its use, sale, transport, delivery or disposal; or
- (ii) Pumping oil, water or sewage; or
- (iii) Generating, transforming or transmitting power; or
- (iv) Composing types for printing by letter press, lithography, photogravure or other similar process or book binding; or
- (v) Constructing, reconstructing, repairing, refitting, finishing or breaking up ships or vessels;

In addition to section 2(m) (i) & 2(m) (ii) of the Factories Act, 1948, electricity units registered with the Central Electricity Authority and Bidi & Cigar units, employing 10 or more workers with the aid of power and 20 or more workers without the aid of power and registered under the Bidi & Cigar Workers (Conditions of Employment) Act, 1966 are also covered in ASI.

#### **Unit of Enumeration**

The primary unit of enumeration in the survey is a factory in the case of manufacturing industries, a workshop in the case of repair services, an undertaking or a licensee in the case of electricity, gas and water supply. The owner of two or more establishments located in the same state and pertaining to the same industry group and belonging to same scheme (census or sample) is, however, permitted to furnish a single consolidated return, termed as 'Joint Return'. Such consolidated returns are a common feature in the case of bidi and cigar establishments, electricity and certain public sector undertakings.

#### **ASI Frame**

The ASI frame is based on the lists of registered factories/units maintained by the Chief Inspector of Factories in each state and those maintained by registration authorities in respect of bidi and cigar establishments and electricity under-takings. The frame is being revised once in three years from 1989-90 but updated every year by the regional offices of the Field Operations Division of NSSO in consultation with the Chief Inspector of Factories in the state. At the time of revision, the names of the de-registered factories are removed from the ASI frame and those of the newly registered factories are added. In updation, only new registrations are added to the existing frame. Inspite of regular updating of the frame, quite a number of small-sized factories selected for the survey are found to be non-existing in the field and are termed as deleted factories. However, such factories are not taken into consideration for the purpose of tabulation and analysis in this report.

All the factories in the frame have been classified into two sectors, viz., the census sector and the sample sector.

The Census Sector consists of the following categories:

- (i) Units having 100 or more workers and
- (ii) All factories covered under Joint return and contributing significantly in terms of GVA.
- (iii) After excluding the census sector units as defined above, all units belonging to the strata(state by 4-digit NIC-2008) having less than or equal to 4 units are also considered as census sector units.

**The Sample sector**: All industrial units of the entire ASI frame minus the Industrial units of the Census Sector will form the sample sector.

Since ASI 1999-2000, all electricity undertakings other than captive units have been kept outdside the purview of ASI. All departmental undertakings such as Railway workshop etc. have also been kept outside the preview of ASI.

#### Sampling Design and Sample Allocation

A new sampling design has been adopted for ASI 2012-13 following the recommendation of Dr. S. L. Shetty Committee and approved by the SCIS subsequently in its 23rd meeting. According to the new sampling design, ASI sample comprises two parts – Central Sample and State Sample. The Central Sample consists of two schemes: Census and Sample. Under Census scheme, all the units are surveyed.

#### (a) Census scheme:

- (i) All industrial units belonging to the six less industrially developed states/ UT's viz.Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- (ii) For the rest of the states/ UT's., (i) units having 100 or more employees, and (ii) all factories covered under Joint Returns.
- (iii) After excluding the Census scheme units, as defined above, all units belonging to the strata(State x District x Sector x 4 digit NIC-2008) having less than or equal to 4 units are also

considered under Census Scheme. It may be noted that in the formation of stratum, the sectors are considered as Bidi, Manufacturing and Electricity.

- (b) All the remaining units in the frame are considered under Sample Scheme. For all the states, each stratum is formed on the basis of State x District x Sector x 4-digit NIC-2008. The units are arranged in descending order of their number of employees. Samples are drawn as per Circular Systematic Sampling technique for this scheme. An even number of units with a minimum of 4 units are selected and distributed in four sub-samples. It may be noted that each of 4 sub-samples from a particular stratum may not have equal number of units.
- (c) Out of these 4 sub-samples, two pre-assigned sub-samples are given to NSSO (FOD) and the other two-subsamples are given to State/UT for data collection.
- (d) The entire census units *plus* all the units belonging to the two sub-samples given to NSSO (FOD) are treated as the Central Sample.
- (e) The entire census units *plus* all the units belonging to the two sub-samples given to State/UT are treated as the State Sample.
- (f) The entire census units *plus* all the units belonging to the two sub-samples given to NSSO (FOD) (Census & Sample) *plus* all the units belonging to the two sub-samples given to State/UT(State sample) are taken together to get the pooled estimates of state as a whole and its constituent districts.

#### 4. Estimation Procedure

#### **Reference Period**

Reference period for ASI 2012-2013 was the accounting year of the factory, ending on any day during the financial year 2012-2013. Thus in ASI 2012-2013 data collected from respective establishment relate to their accounting year ended on any day between 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2012 and 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2013. Survey was conducted in the year 2012-2013 (October, 2013 to May, 2014).

#### **Schedule of Enquiry**

The schedule for ASI 2012-2013 is more or less similar to the ASI schedule 2010-2011, and it aims to collect data on assets and liabilities, employment and labour cost, receipts, expenses, input items - indigenous and imported, products and by-products, distributive expenses etc.

#### **CLASSIFICATION OF INDUSTRIES**

The NIC - 1970 was followed to classify economic activities of the factories from ASI 1973-74 to ASI 1988-89. NIC - 1987 had been introduced and followed till ASI 1997-98. NIC 1998 was then followed from ASI 1998-99 to ASI 2003-04, NIC - 2004 introduced from ASI 2004-05 was followed till ASI 2007-2008. New series of classification i.e. NIC-2008 has been introduced from ASI 2008-09. All the factories in the ASI frame are accordingly classified in their appropriate industry groups on the basis of the value of the principal product manufactured by them. This way a unit gets classified in one and only one industry group even though it might be manufacturing products belonging to different industries. The estimates for different aggregates presented at two or three digit level in this report correspond to the NIC 2008.

#### LIMITATION

All the estimated value figures given in this publication are reported in current prices. The value figures are generally rounded off to lakhs of rupees. All India figures are rounded off separately and thus, may not exactly tally with the sum of districts. Similarly, all-Industry figures may not tally with the sum of individual industry figures. Also the industry-wise totals at lower level may not tally with the next higher level due to necessary mergings at different levels.

The Collection of Statistics Act prohibits disclosure of data relating to individual factories. Therefore, if the number of factories under any industry (2 digit & 3-digit level of NIC-2008) in the state is less than three, the data have been combined to a similar industry, or clubbed in a common industry others in order to conceal the identity of all such units belonging to the concerned stratum.

All the estimates, especially for quantity and value figures for any particular item consumed and produced, are subject to Statistical Error as these are estimated on the basis of a selected sample.

As per tabulation policy it has been decided to publish the detailed information corresponding to industry codes 10, 33, 35,38,43,45,52,58, and 95 following NIC-2008. For all other industry codes the units have been clubbed and shown under a common industry 'Other' in different tables.

### CHAPTER - II CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

**REGISTERED FACTORY** is one which is registered under sections 2m (i) and 2m (ii) of the Factories Act, 1948. The Sections 2m (i) and 2m (ii) refer to any premises including the precincts thereof (a) wherein ten or more workers are working, or were working on any day of the preceding twelve months, and in any part of which a manufacturing process is being carried on with the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on or (b) wherein twenty or more workers are working or were working on any day of the preceding twelve months and in any part of which a manufacturing process is being carried on with the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on or (b) wherein twenty or more workers are working or were working on any day of the preceding twelve months and in any part of which a manufacturing process is being carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on without the aid of power, or is ordinarily so carried on.

**FIXED CAPITAL** represents the depreciated value of fixed assets owned by the factory as on the closing day of the accounting year. Fixed assets are those which have a normal productive life of more than one year. Fixed capital includes land including leasehold land, buildings, plant and machinery, furniture and fixtures, transport equipment, water system and roadways and other fixed assets such as hospitals, schools etc. used for benefit of factory personnel.

**PHYSICAL WORKING CAPITAL** is the total inventories comprising of raw materials and components, fuels and lubricants, spares, stores, semi-finished goods and finished goods as on the closing day of the accounting year. However, it does not include the stock of the materials, fuels, stores etc. supplied by others to the factory for processing and finished goods processed by the factory from raw materials supplied by others.

**INVESTED CAPITAL** is the total of fixed capital and physical working capital.

**WORKING CAPITAL** is the sum of the physical working capital as already defined above and the cash deposits in hand and at bank and the net balance receivable over amounts payable at

the end of the accounting year. Working capital, however, excludes unused overdraft facility, fixed deposits irrespective of duration, advances for acquisition of fixed assets, loans and advances by proprietors and partners irrespective of their purpose and duration, long-term loans including interest thereon and investments.

**PRODUCTIVE CAPITAL** is the total of fixed capital and working capital as defined above.

<u>GROSS VALUE OF PLANT OF MACHINERY</u> represents the total original (un-depreciated) value of installed plant and machinery at the end of the accounting year. It includes the book value of the newly installed plants and machinery and the approximate value of rented in plants and machinery at the time of renting- in but exclude the value of rented- out plants and machinery. Total value of all the plants and machinery acquired on hire - purchase basis is also included.

**WORKERS** are defined to include all persons employed directly or through any agency whether for wages or not and engaged in any manufacturing process or in cleaning any part of the machinery or premises used for manufacturing process or in any other kind of work incidental to or connected with the manufacturing process or the subject of the manufacturing process. Labour engaged, in the repair and maintenance or production of fixed assets for factory's own use or labour employed for generating electricity or producing coal, gas etc. are included.

**EMPLOYEES** include all workers defined above and persons receiving wages and holding supervisory or managerial positions engaged in administrative office, store keeping section and welfare section, sales department as also those engaged in purchase of raw materials etc. or purchase of fixed assets for the factory and watch and ward staff.

**MAN-HOURS** represent the total number of hours worked and the number of hours paid for, during the accounting year. It is obtained by summing-up the number of persons of specified categories attending in each shift-hour over all the shifts worked on all days.

**WAGES AND SALARIES** are defined to include all remuneration in monetary terms and also payable more or less regularly in each pay period to workers as compensation for work done during the accounting year. It includes (a) direct wages and salary (i.e., basic wages/salaries, payment of overtime, dearness, compensatory, house rent and other allowances) ; (b) remuneration for the period not worked (i.e., basic wages, salaries and allowances payable for leave period, paid holiday, lay off payments and compensation for unemployment, if not paid from sources other than employers) ; (c) bonus and ex-gratia payment paid both at regular and less frequent intervals ( i.e., incentive bonuses, good attendance bonuses, productive bonuses, profit sharing bonuses, festival or year-end bonuses etc.). It excludes lay off payments, which are made (1) from trust or other special funds set up exclusively for this purpose i.e. payment not made by the employer. It also excludes imputed value of benefits. (2) In kind, Employer's contribution to old age benefits and other Group benefits. Travelling and other expenditure incurred for business purposes and reimbursed by the employer are excluded. The wages are expressed in terms of gross value i.e., before deduction for fines, damages, taxes, provident fund, employee's state insurance contribution etc.

**<u>TOTAL EMOLUMENTS</u>** is defined as the sum of wages and salaries, employers contribution as provident fund and other funds and workmen and staff welfare expenses as defined above.

**FUELS CONSUMED** represent total purchase value of all items of fuels such as coal. Liquefied petroleum gas, petrol, electricity, lubricants, water etc. consumed by the factory during the accounting year but excluding the items which directly enter into the manufacturing process.

**MATERIALS CONSUMED** represents the total delivered value of all items of raw materials, components, chemicals, packing materials and stores which actually enter into the production process of the factory during the accounting year. It also includes the cost of all materials used for the construction of building etc. for the factory's own use. It, however, excludes all intermediate products consumed during the accounting year. Intermediate products are those products, which are produced by the factory but are subject to further manufacturing.

**TOTAL INPUT** comprises total value of fuels, materials consumed as well as expenditure such as cost of contract and commission work done by others on materials supplied by the factory, cost of materials consumed for repair and maintenance of factory's fixed assets including cost of repairs and maintenance work done by others to the factory's fixed assets, inward freight and transport charges, rate and taxes (excluding income tax), postage, telephone and telex expenses, insurance charges, banking charges, cost of printing and stationery and purchase value of goods sold in the same condition as purchased.

**EX-FACTORY VALUE** of all products and by-products manufactured is attained at the rate of net sale-value which is obtained by deducting sale-tax, excise duties and other distributive expenses from actual sale value (inclusive of subsidies etc.) with respect to each of the items.

**TOTAL OUTPUT** comprises total ex-factory value of products and by-products manufactured as well as other receipts such as receipts from non-industrial services rendered to others, work done for others on material supplied by them, value of electricity produced and sold, sale value of goods sold in the same condition as purchased, addition in stock of semi-finished goods and own construction.

**<u>DEPRECIATION</u>** is consumption of fixed capital due to wear and tear and obsolescence during the accounting year and is taken as provided by the factory owner or is estimated on the basis of cost of installation and working life of the fixed assets.

**SEMI-FINISHED GOODS** refer to the imputed value of all materials which have been partially processed by the factory but which are not usually sold without further processing. It includes the work in progress for materials supplied by others, but excludes the value of semi-finished fixed assets produced for factory's own use

**<u>NET VALUE ADDED</u>** is arrived by deducting total input and depreciation from total output.

#### **CHAPTER-III**


#### **GENERAL REVIEW OF INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY IN 2012-2013**

This chapter highlights the main findings of the survey which inter-alia covers the main sectors of economic activities namely, Manufacturing and Repairing and other service activities. Findings of the survey are based on pooled data of Central Sample and State Sample.

Some of the estimates for principal characteristics for all industries taken together in Delhi during the year 2012-2013 as compared to the corresponding figures available for the year 2011-2012 have been depicted in Table-1 below:

#### **CONCENTRATION OF FACTORIES**

The summary results (Table) revealed that during the reference period of ASI 2012-2013, the larger numbers of factories were engaged in manufacturing of 'Wearing Apparel Dressing and Dying of Fur' (13.04%) followed by 'Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motor cycles, (9.62%), printing and reproduction of recorded media (9.58%) manufacture fabricated metal products of except machinery & equipments, (8.23%), manufacture of leather & related products (7.09%) and Manufacture of Rubber and plastic products ( 6.31%). These six industries together have constituted 53.87 percent of the total working factories, provided employment to 54.98 percent of the total employees and utilized 23.33 percent of fixed capital stock. Their share in the gross value of output and net value added by manufacture were 36.65 and 29.75 percent respectively.

A decrease of 21.39% in the working capital during current year from previous year was due to major fall in the working capital of mainly two industrial groups i.e. Mfg of food items (10) and Mfg of Wearing Apparel (14) having shares of 25.37% and 7.30% in the total working capital estimated. These two industrial groups had experienced drastic fall the working capital by 32.64% and 48.35% respectively from the year 2011-12.

## DISTRIBUTION OF FACTORIES BY TYPE OF ORGANISATION, OWNERSHIP, & YEAR OF INITIAL PRODUCTION

In the following paragraphs, some of the characteristics of the factories covered in the survey, like, type of organisation, ownership and the year of initial production have been discussed.

**ORGANISATION:** The distribution of the factories covered according to the various types of organisation is given in the table 2

The study of the table-2 reveals that:

- (1) Factories under the group 'Pvt. Limited company' numbering 1266 (39.77%) were the highest in the factory sector, followed by 'Individual proprietorship' 1055 units (33.14%), Partnership 775 (24.35%).
- (2) In the Census Sector, Pvt. Ltd. Company 468 (50.70%), Individual Proprietorship 221 (23.94%), Partnership 211 (22.86%) have taken the first three ranks.
- (3) The pattern in the Sample sector, however was slightly different i.e. Individual Proprietorship 834
   (36.90%) occupied the top position, followed by Pvt. Limited company 798(35.31%) as
   Partnership 564 (24.96%).

The study of the table –3 reveals that out of 3183 factories covered under ASI 2012-2013, 3139 units representing 98.62% of the total belonged to wholly Private Enterprises. The corresponding figures from Census & Sample sectors are 98.16% & 98.81% respectively.

#### (b) Year of Initial Production

It would be seen from the table 4 that:-

(1) Out of total 3183 units covered, only 27 (0.85 %) has started their production before 1951. The survey result reveals a continuous upward trend in the numbers of factories according to their year of initial production. Maximum numbers of factories are returned in the period 2001-10 as 888 (27.90%).

- In the Census Sector, the maximum numbers of 242 units (26.22%) were set up in the period 2001-10, while 223 units (24.16%) during 1991-2000.
- (3) Similarly in Sample Sector the maximum numbers of 646 units (28.58%) were setup in the decrease 2001-2010 and 542 units (23.98%) in the decrease 1991-2000.

#### **CAPITAL STRUCTURE**

During the reference period 2012-2013, the fixed capital invested in the factories covered under the survey was estimated at  $\gtrless$  10660.80 crore, productive capital  $\gtrless$  18798.25 crore and invested capital  $\gtrless$ 19854.14 crore. Fixed capital and Invested capital are higher by 19.28 percent and 14.75 percent whereas productive capital decreased by 2.55% compared to those estimated during the corresponding period of 2011-12. From the investment angle, industries such as Mfg. of Food Products (10), Mfg. of Wearing Apparel (14), Mfg. of Chemicals and Chemical products (20), Wholesale and retail trade, Repair of Motor vehicles and Motor cycles (45) were the most important ones. These industries among themselves shared 23.53 percent of fixed capital, 44.05 percent of invested capital and 567.84 percent of working capital deployed in all the industries taken together.

Table-5 given below depicts the relative share of the census and sample sector in the capital structure, as also certain important ratios, and derived ratios.

#### The study of the table reveals that:

The 923 Census Sector Factories constituting 29.00 percent of factory sector deployed a major share of the capital resources of factory sector viz. ₹ 15005 crore or 75.58 percent of the total Invested Capital, ₹13337 crore or 70.95 percent of the total 'Productive Capital' and ₹8325 crore or 78.09 percent of the total 'Fixed Capital'.

The invested capital per unit' worked out to ₹16.26 crore in the census sector and 2.15 crore in the sample sector and ₹ 6.24 crore in the factory sector as a whole. This indicates that employment potential, with limited resources is more in the small size units than in the large size units.

Details of 'Invested',' Productive' and 'Fixed Capital' their percentage distribution and certain important derived ratios at the Major Industry groups and Industry Groups at 2 digit level of National Industrial Classification (NIC-2008) have been shown in Table II given in Part II of the report.

#### Table -- II, Shows That:-

- (i) Among the Industry Groups at 2 digit of NIC-08, two major contributors in the invested capital were Industry Group 35- Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning Supply and Industry Group 10 Manufacturing of Food Products with contribution of ₹4583.74 crore. (23.09%) and ₹4420.26 cr. (22.26%) respectively. Similarly, in the fixed capital in the factory sector were Groups 35- Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning Supply and Group 14- Mfg. of Wearing Apparel with contributions of ₹ 4499 cr. (42.2%) and ₹ 714.84 cr. (6.71%).
- (ii) The lowest contribution on the other hand was that of Major Industry Group 96- Other Personal Service Activities contributing 0.01% in the invested capital as well as in the fixed capital in the factory sector.
- (iii) The Fixed capital to invested Capital ratio is work out to 0.54 in the factory sector. The Ratio is the highest (0.98) in major industry group-35 Electricity, gas steam and air conditioning supply.

Table –6 below depicts the distribution of factories according to capital size (Gross value of plant and machinery) being adopted for classification of industrial units into small and large units, separately for the census, sample and factory sectors.

The perusal of table-6 reveals that 1696 (53.28%) units have an investment of less than ₹1.00 crore in the Plant and Machinery and above. while there were only 1487 (46.72%) unit have an investment of over ₹1.00 crore in the Plant & Machinery.

#### **EMPLOYMENT**

The number of persons employed in the Factory Sector during 2012-2013 worked out to 126354 out of these, 81901 (64.82%) were workers engaged exclusively in the production and/or repair services and the remaining 44453 (35.18%) were other employees including supervisory, managerial, clerical and auxiliary staff, working proprietors and unpaid family workers. As against this, the

corresponding figures for the year 2011-2012 were 76867 and 41911 indicating considerable increase of 6.55 percent and increase of 6.07 percent respectively in the year 2012-2013.

The total number of 'mandays worked', by all employees during the current year was 376 lakh compared to 359 lakh during 2011-12 showing thereby, increase of 4.74 percent over previous year.

Table –7 below shows employment, mandays worked and certain important ratios derived therefrom separately for the census, sample and factory sectors.

#### The perusal of table 7 reveals that:-

- (i) Out of the 81901 workers in the factory sector 43500 workers (53.11%) were engaged in the census sector while the remaining 38401 workers (46.89%) were employed in sample sector.
- (ii) Per unit employment of workers in the census sector was 47 compared to 17 in the sample sector and 26 in the factory sector. The corresponding averages in the case of all employees worked out to 73, 26 and 40 for census, sample and factory sectors respectively.
- (iii) The respective share of Census and sample sector factories in the total mandays worked in the factory sector was 54.53 percent and 45.47 percent respectively.
- Mandays worked per employees per year in the census sector was 305 as compared to 290 in the sample sector and 298 in the factory sector as a whole.

The table-8 depicts the distribution of factories covered according to the employment size of workers in census, sample and factory sectors as revealed by ASI 2012-2013.

The study of the table –8 shows that:

- (i) The maximum number of 603 units forming 18.94 percent of the factory sector, employed 50-99 workers. The employment size group 20-49 workers with 580 units (18.22%) came next followed by employment size group 100-199 workers with 541 units (17.00%).
- (ii) Within the census sector, 488 out of 923 units, i.e. 52.87% have less than 50 workers and 116 units (12.57%) having 50-99 workers and 319 units (34.56%) have more than 100 workers.

(iii) In the sample sector, 29.47 percent of the units (666 out of 2260) employed less than 50 workers each. As many as 487 units constituting 21.55 percent of total units in the sample sector employed 50-99 workers each. Further, 1107 units constituting 48.98 percent of the sample sector reported employment 100 or more workers.

#### **EMOLUMENTS**

A total sum of ₹ 2577.56 crore was paid as emoluments to all employees during 2012-2013 of which ₹1030.88 crore were paid as wages to workers and remaining ₹1546.68 crore represented payment to other employee's bonus and value of benefits in kind etc. The share of census and sample sector factories in the case of the total emoluments to all employees was ₹ 1666 crore (64.64%) and ₹911 crore (35.34%) respectively whereas in the case of wages to workers it was ₹620.55 crore (60.20%) and ₹ 410.33 crore (39.80%) respectively.

The total emoluments paid to all employees, wages to workers and some important derived ratios have been indicated in the table 9 given below:-

The above table reveals that the employees as well as workers in the census sector were better paid than those in sample sector. The census sector constituted only 29.00 percent of the factory sector, claimed 64.64 percent of the wages paid to employees. The average emoluments per employee per man-day for the census sector worked out to ₹678.21 as against ₹ 422.65 for the sample sector and ₹558.89 for the factory sector as a whole. The reasons for the difference in the emoluments in the two sectors are obvious. The factories in the census sector are generally highly mechanized and employ a greater percentage of skilled persons who are better paid than others.

The comparative position in respect of total emoluments paid to all employees, salaries and wages paid to workers etc, the major industry groups has been indicated in table II, given in part – II of the report. Some of the salient features revealed from the study of this table are:

- (i) The total emoluments paid to all employees were the maximum at ₹53432 lakh (20.73%) in the Major Industry Group 14- Mfg. of Wearing Apparel followed by 32244 lakh (12.51%) in the Major Industry Group 45 Wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicle and motorcycles, and 32000 (12.41%) in Major Industry Group 10 Mfg. of food products. The three groups together shared almost 45% of the total emoluments paid in the factory sector.
- (ii) The average emoluments per employee per annum ₹ 1050683 is the maximum in the Major Industry Group 58 publishing Activities, while it is the lowest at ₹ 107184 in the Major Industry Group, 24-Mfg. of Basic Metals. However, the average emoluments per employee per year for the factory sector worked out to ₹203995.
- (iii) The total wages of ₹31346 lakh (30.41%) paid to the workers in the Major Industry Group 14-Mfg. of Wearing Apparel Dressing and Dying of Fur were the maximum. The Major Industry Group 10-Manufacturing of Food Products with ₹11770 lakh (11.42%) came next. The two groups together accounted for 41.83% of the total wages paid in the factory sector.

#### INPUTS

Inputs, in any industrial activity mainly consists of consumption of raw materials and stores (used for manufacture, repair and maintenance purposes), 'fuels' materials consumed and also other inputs viz (a) cost of non-industrial services received from others (b) cost of materials consumed for repair & maintenance of factory's fixed assets including cost of work done by others to the factory's fixed assets (c) cost of contract and commission work done by others on materials supplied by the factory (d) cost of office supplies and products reported for sale during last year and used for further manufacture during the accounting year.

The total value of the inputs, other than labour input and depreciation in the factory sector worked out to  $\gtrless$  49024.05 crore. Out of this, consumption of materials being the principal components accounted for  $\gtrless$  27965.64 (57.04%) crore of the total value of input. The remaining 21058.41 crore were shared by 'fuels' and 'other inputs' their relevant values being  $\gtrless$ 982.40 crore (2.00%) and  $\end{Bmatrix}$  20076.01 crore (40.93%) respectively.

The table below indicates the percentage consumption of different components of inputs in the census, sample & factory sectors.

The perusal of the table-10 reveals some of interesting facts which are as under:-

- (1) The census sector factories, constituting 29.00 percent of the total factories covered shared 61.46 percent of the total inputs, while the sample sector, forming 71.00 percent of the factories accounted for only 38.54 percent of the total inputs.
- (2) The percentage share in the total consumption of 'materials' 'fuels' and 'other inputs' in the case of census sector was 60.21 percent, 44.70 percent and 64.03 percent respectively. The relevant percentages in the case of sample sector were 39.79 percent, 55.30 percent and 35.97 percent in that order.

(3) Within the two sectors, the percentage share of the constituents of 'total inputs' varied considerably. In the census sector 'material consumed', 'fuel consumed' and 'other inputs' accounted for 55.88 percent, 1.46 percent and 42.66 percent respectively compared to 58.90 percent, 2.88 percent and 38.22 percent respectively for the sample sector as against 57.04 percent, 2.00 percent and 40.95 percent respectively for the factory sector as a whole.

Some of the salient features revealed by the study of the results of the survey detailed in table II given in part II of the report are as follows:-

- (i) Major Industry Group 10 'Mfg of Food products' shares 34.49 percent of the total inputs in the factory sector followed by Group-45 'Wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicle and motorcycles', Group 14 'Manufacturing of Wearing Apparel', Group 27- 'Mfg. of Electrical Equipment', sharing 20.52%, 7.57%, and 5.35 percent respectively of total inputs. These four industry groups together accounted for 67.93 percent of the total inputs in the factory sector.
- (ii) Within the Major Industry Groups, the percentage share of 'Material Consumed' to total input of the Major Industry Groups varied considerably. It was the highest in the Major Industry Group 19-'Mfg of coke & refined petroleum products' at 96.59% and the lowest at 3.62% in the Major Industry Group 95-'Repair of computers & personnel household goods'.

#### DEPRECIATION

Depreciation means 'consumption of fixed capital' during the manufacturing process. It is estimated on the basis of cost and 'productive life' of the fixed assets concerned.

As shown in table-10 of part II the total estimated value of depreciation for all the fixed assets in the factory sector, as per ASI 2012-2013 worked out to ₹ 70821 lakh. The average rate of depreciation calculated on the basis of 'total fixed capital engaged in the production activity during the survey year, worked to 7 percent in the factory sector.

The table-11 given below depicts the average rate of depreciation as percentage of fixed capital in some major industry groups.

#### **OUTPUT**

Output in an industry includes products, by-products and services generated during the industrial process. The value of total output worked out to ₹57858.48 crore as compared to ₹ 50899.98 crore in 2011-12 indicating thereby an increase of 13.67 percent over the previous year. The worth of products and by-products is ₹ 35106.05 crore whereas ₹ 22752.43 crore is worth of 'other output' including services rendered to others and sale value of goods sold in the same condition, as purchased.

The relative contribution of the census and sample sectors in the 'total output', 'products and by-products' and some important ratios derived there from have been shown in the table given below:-

#### The study of the table 12 reveals that:

- (i) The Census Sector constituting 62.88 % of the 'total output' in the Factory Sector, while its share in the case of 'Products and by-Products', and 'other output' worked out to 61.74 % and 64.64 % respectively. While in sample sector comprising 37.12 % of the total output. Its share in products and by-products is 38.26% and in other outputs is 35.36%
- (ii) The 'output' per unit 'Invested Capital' ratio at 4.43 in the Sample Sector was higher as compared to 2.42 in the Census Sector and 2.91 in the Factory Sector as a whole.
- (iii) The average 'value of output per worker' per annum was higher in the Census sector than in factory and sample sector. The relevant figures for Census Sector, Sample Sector and Factory Sector are ₹ 83.64 lakh, ₹ 55.92 lakh and ₹ 70.64 lakh respectively.
- (iv) 'Production per manday', being the measure of the productivity in an industrial activity,
   'Productivity' in the Census Sector at ₹ 17741 was higher compared to ₹ 12561 in the Sample Sector and ₹ 15385 in the Factory Sector.
- (v) Output-Input ratio, on the other hand, was 1.21 in Census sector, 1.14 in Sample sector and
   1.18 in Factory sector as a whole.

The details of 'output', 'Products and by-Products', and 'other output', etc. within Major Industry Groups are indicated in table-II of Part II of the Report. The study thereof depicts that:-

(i) The contribution of Major Industry Group 10-'Mfr. of Food products & beverages', approx. at ₹18303 crore worth of output accounting for 31.63 percent of the total products was the maximum. Major Industry Groups, 45- 'Wholesale and retail trades & repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles' with 18.87 percent, Industry 14-'Mfg. of wearing apparel', 7.76 percent, 20-'Mfg. of Chemical & Chemical Products' with 6.09 percent 27- 'Mfg. of Electrical equipments' with 5.38 percent came next in that order. These five Major Industry Groups together contributes around 69.53 percent of the total output in the factory sector.

#### The study of table 13 reveals that:-

- (1) The 'pattern of the cost of production' in factories in the census and the sample sectors differed substantially particularly in respect of share of fuels, emoluments, and factor payments in their respective total cost structure in the two sectors.
- (2) The 'total value of inputs' (materials, fuels and other inputs) and employee emolument, factor payment taken together constituted 91.83 percent of the 'total value of output' in the census sector, 96.13 percent in the sample sector and 93.48 percent in the factory sector as a whole.

- (3) The contribution of materials and stores components of inputs was 48.33 percent of the total output in the factory Sector. The relevant figures were 46.28 percent for the census sector and 51.81 percent for the sample sector.
- (4) The share of 'fuels' also varied substantially in the three sectors. It was only 1.21 percent of the value of output in the census sector, 2.53 percent in the sample sector and 1.70 percent in the factory sector.
- (5) The other important factor of the cost viz. 'emoluments' formed only 4.58 percent of 'total output' in the census sector, 4.24 percent in the sample sector and 4.45 percent in the factory sector.
- (6) The percentage contribution of factor payments was 3.20 percent of 'total value of output' in the census sector, 2.70 percent in the sample sector and 3.02 percent in the factory sector.

#### VALUE ADDED BY MANUFACTURER

Value added by manufacture is a measure of the relative importance of the industrial sector in State / National economy as well as a measure of the relative importance of a particular industry within the industrial sector itself. It is used to measure the contribution of Industrial Sector in the State / National Domestic Product. The contribution of the Organised Industrial sector (factory sector) in the state domestic product of Delhi during the year 2012-2013 worked out to ₹ 8126.23 crore.

The study of the table reveals that:-

- (i) The share of the Census Sector, constituting 29.00 percent of the total factories covered, was
   ₹ 5803.54 crore or 71.42 percent of the total value added by manufacture while it worked out to ₹ 2322.69 crore or 28.58 percent of the total for the Sample Sector.
- (ii) 'Value added Invested Capital ratio' or the 'Value added per unit of Invested Capital', was
   0.48 in the Sample Sector, 0.39 in the Census Sector and 0.41 in the Factory Sector indicating relatively better return on the Invested Capital in the Sample Sector.
- (iii) The "Value added per worker' at ₹ 1334147 in the Census sector is higher as compared to ₹ 604851 in the Sample Sector and ₹992201 in the Factory Sector.
- (iii) The 'Value added per employee' in the, Census, sample and Factory Sectors were ₹862339, ₹393316 and ₹643131 respectively.



#### **Distribution of Factories in Districts**

The results revealed that maximum numbers of factories are set up in outer Delhi i.e. South and North West districts sharing 29.53% and 28.63% of the total factories, followed by West district with 26.04%. On the other hand, Districts New Delhi, North East, North and South West are least industrialized, all sharing only 6.22% of the total. Most densely populated district i.e. East district is having 6.44% of total industries and District Central shares 3.09% factories.



#### **Capital Structure**

On the other hand, among all 4 less industrialized districts, South West district is having invested capital of ₹ 29660 lakh with only 85 units i.e. invested capital per unit ₹ 348.94 lakhs, which is highest among these 4 districts and indicates concentration of big industries in this district.

In the three most industrialized districts namely, south, north-west and west share of total fixed capital, total invested capital and total working capital are 92.69%, 93.27% and 82.70% respectively. Invested Capital per unit and Productive capital per unit are the highest in the North-West District. Invested Capital and Productive Capital per unit are returned as 1237.29 lakh and 996.80 lakh respectively in this district.

#### **Employment & Emoluments**

District South provided gainful employment to 30677 workers i.e. 37.46% of the total workers which was maximum among all 9 districts. Further, districts south, north-west and west were sharing 36.58%, 26.45% and 24.08% of the total employees. Similarly, worker/employee ratio was highest in case of district west which indicates presence of labour intensive industries, while the same ratio is lowest for district New Delhi showing presence of higher number of managers, supervisors and clerks in the total employee. Table shows employment, emoluments, mandays worked and certain important ratios district wise-

- (i) Per unit average employment was the highest 51 for district South West and the lowest 19 for district North.
- (ii) Mandays worked per employee per year was the lowest 260 in case of district Central and was the highest 319 for district South-West.
- (iii) Average annual wage rate per worker was the highest as ₹ 168586 for district South-West and was the lowest with ₹ 95652 for district North-East. However, average annual emolument per

employee was the highest with ₹ 558313 in case of district Central and the lowest with ₹ 159724 in case of district North.

- a) Production per manday i.e. average output per employee mandays was the highest as ₹ 38683 in the district East and the lowest as ₹ 6654 in district South-West.
- b) Maximum and minimum average values of Output per worker per annum were approx. ₹ 210 lakhs and 30 lakhs in districts East and South-West respectively.
- c) Output-Invested capital ratio was the highest 6.66 in district Central and was the lowest 2.05 in district North-West.
- d) Output-input ratio was the lowest 1.05 for district New Delhi and was the highest 2.91 for district Central.



The study of the table reveals that :-

- District North-West contributed a maximum value of ₹ 301315 lakh among all 9 districts i.e. 37.08% of the total as depicted in the graph. Other major contributors were districts South, West, Central and district East sharing 27.02%, 15.18%, 13.24% and 4.45% respectively. Thus, these entire five districts shared 96.98% of the total value added of the Delhi.
- Value Added per worker' at ₹ 10468937 was maximum for District Central and at ₹ 470932 was minimum in case of District North.
- 3) 'Value Added per employee' estimated as ₹ 2918212 for District Central and ₹ 224115 for District New Delhi were maximum and minimum values respectively.

#### District-wise comparison of major characteristics, ASI 2011-12 & 2012-13

- Six out of nine districts in Delhi have registered a decline in the number of factories during the ASI year 2012-13 as compare to 2011-12. However, South and West districts have witnessed a considerable increase in the number of factories by 151 (19.1%) and 85 (11.4%) respectively over the year.
- As a whole, Delhi shows a growth of 6.55% in the number of workers as compare to 2011-12. Highly industrialized districts, namely, south, west and north-west districts show an increase in the number of workers 12.7%, 7.2% and 4.3% respectively. Three districts out of nine have shown decrease in number of workers. These three districts are North (-18.4%), North East (-23.9%), East (-30.5%).
- Number of employees has also increased in these three highly industrialized districts of South (12.8%), West (6.3%), and North-West (1.2%).
- Total Emolument paid is the highest in the district South (Rs. 88308 lakh) and it constitutes 34.3% of total emoluments paid.
- In respect of Gross Value Added (GVA), district North-West excels in the list with its 37.2% share in total GVA, followed by district South with its share of 27.6%. District North-West has exhibited a drastic growth in GVA by 83.2% from the previous year 2011-12.
