## **PREFACE**

The Report 'Sixth Economic Census: Profile of Local Bodies, Delhi' is prepared on the basis of unit level data provided by Central statistics Office (CSO), Economic Census Division, Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, Government of India. The primary data was collected during February- June, 2013 through schedule 6A. This supplementary publication has been presented to provide the key indicators of economic activities pursued during the year 2013 in five local bodies of Delhi. It is pertinent to mention that district level data has already been released in public domain through our first publication '**Report on Sixth Economic Census , Delhi**', by the month of February, 2016.

The data in the report is presented at local body level and provides various indicators of economic activities in Delhi. Detailed information on various characteristics of the entrepreneurial activities viz. location, kind of ownership, nature of operation, employment status, sources of finance etc. are also presented in the report. The data at local body and ward level will be of great use in planning & development work at the lower level of administrative setup.

The huge task of conduct of Sixth Economic Census was undertaken by Directorate of Economics and Statistics. The whole hearted participation by the Principals/ Vice- Principals of Govt. schools designated as Charge Officers, school teachers of GNCTD, Local Bodies, Anganwadi & Asha Workers & Govt. Officials and unemployed youths worked as Supervisors and Enumerators for conduct of field work of sixth Economic Census is highly appreciated. We are also grateful to the households and entrepreneurs who have made this economic census a success by providing requisite information to enumerators.

I place on record my special gratitude for the tireless efforts put by all the officers and staff of DES and Planning Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi for overall supervision of field work, providing training to all field functionaries and scrutiny of filled-in schedules within stipulated time period. # SIXTH ECONOMIC CENSUS IN DELHI: PROFILE OF LOCAL BODIES

## *EXECUTIVE SUMMARY*

### **1. NUMBER OF ESTABLISHMENTS**

- The total number of establishments found to be operating in NCT of Delhi during 2013 comes to 8,75,308.
- Sixth economic census registered an annual growth rate of 1.94%. In absolute term, there is an increase of 1,17,565 establishments over fifth economic census conducted during 2005.
- Break-up of establishments in agricultural and non-agricultural reveals that 7,008 (0.80%) belong to first category and 8,68,300 (99.20%) to second.

### **2. TYPE OF ESTABLISHMENTS**

- Out of the total establishments, 4,77,498 (54.55%) were Own Account Enterprises (OAE) and 3,97,810 (45.45%) were establishments with atleast one hired worker.
- 'Trade', 'Manufacturing', and 'Transportation' combinedly emerged as the main major economic activities with the largest number of establishments (68.46% of total).

### **3. EMPLOYMENT**

- 30,19,781 persons were employed in 8,75,308 establishments with an average of 3.45 employee per establishment.
- 19.72% of workers were working in the establishments with no hired worker i.e. in OAE. Remaining 80.28% were working in establishments with at least one hired worker.
- In the establishments with hired worker, persons per establishment is worked out to 6.09 as against 1.25 in the case of OAE.
- It is revealed that 89.97% of establishments were of employment size class 1- 5, followed by 6.53% of size class 6 –9, 3.32% of size class 10-99 and the rest 0.17% were of employment size class of 100 & above.
- 97.10% establishments were perennial, 2.16% were seasonal and 0.74 % were working on casual basis.

- 90.94% of the total establishments were proprietary in nature. 77.22% of total employment was under the ownership type 'Private proprietary'.

#### 4. PROFILE OF LOCAL BODIES

- MCD North excels with the highest number of enterprises, i.e. 3.64 lacs (41.6% of total), followed by MCD South with 2.59 lacs (29.6%) and MCD East with 2.38 lacs (27.2%).
- the concentration of establishments per lac of population, MCD East shows the highest concentration with 6,045 establishments per lac of population, followed by MCD North with 5,822 establishments per lac population.
- proportion of establishments located outside the household with fixed structure was maximum in NDMC (90%), followed by Delhi Cantt. (62%) and MCD North (66%).
- Proportion of establishments operated from the household was the highest in MCD East (34%), followed by Delhi cantt. (32%) and MCD South (27%).
- Around 29% of establishments were run outside the household without any structure in MCD East and 24% in MCD South.
- All the LBs are showing number of perennial establishments by more than 96%.
- The highest numbers of persons were employed in North MCD with 13.6 lacs person employed, followed by 8.98 lacs in South MCD and 6.29 lacs in East MCD. On the other hand, average number of person per establishment is the highest in New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) with 10.5 workers per establishment.
- Maximum of establishments were coming under size class of employment of 1-5 for all the local Bodies and State as a whole. Most of the big establishments with employment size 50 & above were concentrated in MCD North (2,753) and MCD South (1,780).
- Among the 8,75,308 establishments in Delhi, 90.94% were proprietary establishments. Further, 8.85% of total proprietary establishments were running under female entrepreneurship in Delhi. The highest proportion of female entrepreneurship was observed in MCD East (10.95%), closely followed by MCD South (9.55%).

## CHAPTER ONE

### INTRODUCTION

Economic Census is the complete enumeration of entrepreneurial activities operating in the geographical boundaries of State/Country at a given point of time to come out with the official count of enterprises and their characteristics. The subject of coverage under the Sixth Economic Census briefly includes all types of entrepreneurial activities in the field of agricultural (except crop production and plantation) as well as non-agricultural. Entrepreneurial activities mean, all those economic activities dealing with the production and/or distribution of goods/services not solely for the purpose of own consumption. To illustrate, a Tailor engaged in the tailoring activity and charges for the service is included and a housewife stitching the clothes of family members alone, as a part of her domestic work is excluded for the purpose of Economic census.

All economic activities - agricultural and non-agricultural, except those involved in crop production and plantation, public administration, Defence and compulsory social security, related to production and/or distribution of goods and/or services were covered. The main agricultural activities covered under the Sixth Economic Census include livestock production, agricultural support activities, hunting, forestry, logging, fishing and aquaculture. Non-agricultural field of activity covered by Economic Census operations includes mining & quarrying, manufacturing, electricity, gas & water supply, sewerage, waste management, construction, wholesale & retail trade, transport & storage, accommodation & food service, information & communication, financial & insurance, real estate, professional, scientific & technical, administrative & support service, education, human health & social work, arts; entertainment & recreation etc. The above said activities whether they are in household or institutional, private or public were covered without exception. However, as were done earlier Censuses, following activities were kept out of the preview of the 6th EC:

- a. Establishments of shelter-less and nomadic population, which keep on moving from place to place and camp either without shelter or with makeshift shelter.
- b. Establishments engaged in some illegal activities like smuggling, gambling, beggary, prostitution, etc.
- c. Domestic servants, whether they work in one household or in a number of households, drivers, etc. who undertake jobs for other on wages.
- d. Household members engaged in household chores.
- e. Households in which none of the members is engaged in any gainful activity i.e. households depending on remittance, rent, interest, pension etc.

#### ECONOMIC CENSUS IN PERSPECTIVE

The first Economic Census was conducted in India in 1977. The coverage of the Census was confined to non-agricultural establishments. The census did not cover own-account and agricultural enterprises. The items of information collected from each establishment were its location, description of activity, total number and the number of hired persons usually working by gender, type of ownership, activity, power/fuel used for carrying out the activity, value of annual output/turnover/receipts mixed activity or not, registered/licensed/recognized or not, and

act/authority, if registered. In addition to the above, a schedule giving village amenities in rural areas was also canvassed. A mixed approach was followed for collection of requisite data. It was complete house listing in the entire urban area and in those villages (contiguous, compact and well identifiable area units) with a census population of more than 5000. In other smaller villages (i.e. villages with 5000 population or less), a village level enquiry was made to list establishments and they were later visited and establishments were canvassed, wherever warranted.

The second and third Economic Censuses were clubbed with the house listing operations of Population Censuses conducted in 1980 and 1990 respectively keeping in view the operational convenience and cost effectiveness. The censuses had wide scope and coverage than that of the first one. Both own account enterprises and establishments, agricultural and non-agricultural enterprises were covered. The items on which information was collected under these censuses were more or less the same as those collected in the first Economic Census. However, based on the field problems faced and experience gained in the first Economic Census, the collection of information relating to value of output/turnover/receipts was dropped. Domestic workers engaged by household (maids) were also not included in the coverage of Economic Census. The same line of approach was adopted under the Fourth (1998), Fifth (2005) and Sixth Economic Census (2013) as well. New feature added during the fifth and sixth Economic census was canvassing of a separate schedule "Address slip/Directory of Establishments" among the enterprises employing 10 or more workers for compilation of a Directory of larger establishments.

#### **ECONOMIC CENSUS: OBJECTIVE**

The main objectives behind the conduct of Economic census are explained below:

- The Economic Census which mainly gives activity-wise and area-wise head count of enterprises, employment and other main characteristics in numerical terms and their growth over a period of time gives a measure of impact of policies of Government in this regard.
- To provide detail information on operational and economic variables, activity wise, of all the establishments of all the States/Countries including its distribution at lower geographical levels like tehsil/villages in case of rural areas and towns/wards in case of urban areas for decentralized planning.
- To generate information on number of exporting establishments, employing 10 or more workers, activity- wise and area- wise in operation.
- To provide updated Directory of Establishments employing 10 or more workers for local level planning purposes and also for using a 'list frame' for conduct of survey of such establishments in the non-manufacturing/services sector, and
- It provides area sample frame for follow-up surveys. The follow-up surveys give out data on size, region, distribution, employment, value added of each of non- agricultural sector. This will help bridge data gaps in the unorganized sector of the economy. The rationale behind the repetition of this exercise periodically is to update the database.



## **GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE**

The 6th Economic Census was conducted in Rural as well as Urban areas of Delhi without exception. Rural area consists of 112 Census villages. Census villages refer to those areas classified and covered as villages during 2011 Population Census conducted by Registrar General of India (RGI).

Urban area of Delhi comprised of three statutory towns viz. Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC), Delhi Cantonment and Census towns. Census towns are those villages having a population of 5000 and above, at least 75% of male working population are employed in non-agricultural activities and density of population is at least 400 per sq. km., covered as urban areas during Population Census 2011 by RGI. There were 110 such Census Towns in Delhi.

The unit of survey in both rural and urban areas was the Enumeration Blocks (EBs) used in Population Census 2011 by ORGI. The total number of such blocks covered during the course of field work was about 33,210.

## **STEERING COMMITTEE**

A State Level Steering Committee was constituted in February-2012 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Govt. Of NCT of Delhi. The committee inter alia included representatives from Department of Finance, Planning, Services, Education, Labour, Industry, Divisional Commissioner, Development Commissioner, MCD, NDMC, Delhi Cantonment Board and the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, Govt. of India.

## **FUNDS**

The Plan Scheme of 6th Economic Census is fully funded by Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, Government of India. The total outlay at the national level is Rs. 763.49 crores. Out of this, an amount of Rs. 10.51 crores (1.4%) was provided to Delhi. Under the scheme, two posts of officers (Assistant Director, Statistical Officer) and five posts of officials (four Statistical Assistants, one LDC/Typist) were created in this Directorate on temporary basis during the period of the scheme.

## **MANPOWER DEPLOYMENT & TRAINING**

For the conduct of field work of Economic Census, teachers of Local Bodies, Anganwadi workers, Asha Workers and 12<sup>th</sup> pass unemployed youths were deployed as enumerators and teachers of Directorate of Education and officers/staff of Planning & Statistical cadre besides some other category of government staff were deployed as supervisors on part time basis. In all, 5,300 enumerators, 4,700 supervisors and 92 Charge officers were deployed for conduct of field work. Overall supervision was done by the officers of Planning & Statistical cadre. The teachers deployed for Economic Census were given seven days special Earned Leaves apart from the honorarium for conducting the field work. Teachers/other official and unemployed youths deployed for the conduct of field work were given two days training in batches and trainings were imparted during January-March, 2013 by the officers of this Directorate/Planning Department.

## **PERIOD OF FIELD OPERATIONS**

The field work of 6<sup>th</sup> Economic Census was initially planned during February-March, 2013. The field work was inaugurated in the first week of February, 2013 by the Hon'ble Chief Minister. Due to non-availability of adequate number of teachers and heavy dropout of unemployed youths the field work could be completed by June, 2013.

## **SCHEDULES CANVASSED**

Three schedules namely, (i) House and Establishment Listing Schedule, (ii) Establishment Abstract, and (iii) Directory of Establishment Schedule were used in the sixth Economic Census.

## **PUBLICITY**

### **METHODOLOGY**

During the course of field work, dual approach was adopted for covering the entrepreneurial activities. In respect of establishments operated with fixed structure, such units were covered at the place of their operation. On the other hand, economic activities that are carried out without any fixed structures or location were accounted at respective households (residence). This was done to ensure the complete coverage of the activities without exception. The actual work of enumeration was done on house to house basis, covering the length and breadth of Delhi.

Wide publicity campaign was organized through print media by releasing series of advertisements in the leading news papers of Hindi, English, Urdu, Punjabi languages soliciting cooperation for providing information under the Economic Census. All Resident Welfare Association (RWAs) and Trader's Associations associated with 'Baghidari' scheme were also sensitized by sending letters and pamphlets. Apart from this, Government of India had publicized through TV and other electronic media.

## **LIMITATIONS OF SIXTH ECONOMIC CENSUS**

The limitations of data generated under the 6th Economic Census are discussed below keeping in view the interest of users of this data.

The method of collection of data under Economic Census is not record- based information but only oral information provided by the informants. In this method under reporting of employment, unintended accuracy, recall lapse and casual approach on the part of the informants is likely to some extent.

Majority of enumerators deployed under the sixth Economic Census in Delhi were unemployed youths/students, Asha workers and Anganwadi workers who were totally new to such type of work. The limited availability of the services of the school teachers who are considered to be

seasoned field workers for such type of enumeration work, was felt during the course of organization of field work

Although certain improvements were made in the schedule to guard against under-listing of establishments (particularly the home-based units or those operating without fixed structures), data as per sixth economic Census may be subject to some amount of coverage error on account of such under-listing, which is difficult to eliminate totally in a massive census operation.

Despite the above limitations, the data collected under the 6<sup>th</sup> Economic Census is expected to fulfill the needs of planners and other data users richly.

## CHAPTER TWO

### CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Concepts and definitions of the important terms used in Sixth Economic Census are detailed below:

#### **ESTABLISHMENT**

An establishment is a unit or an economic entity situated in a single location in which predominantly one kind of economic activity is carried out such that at least a part of the goods and /or services produced by the unit is sold. For example, it can be an office providing services to the consumers/clients on fee or payment basis, a shop selling the provisions of day to day consumption /use, a factory producing or manufacturing a goods item, or a house where an economic activity is carried out by the member(s) within the household by themselves or by hiring person(s) or with a combination of the two. The activity may be carried out within fixed premises/permanent structure or without having any permanent structure.

#### **AGRICULTURAL ESTABLISHMENT**

An agricultural establishment for the purpose of this Census is one engaged in production of agriculture good (other than crop production & plantation by the farmers or a group of farmers or any agency), agricultural services, hunting, trapping & game propagation, livestock production, forestry and logging as well as fishing and aquaculture, where at least some part of the production or services is sold out. Establishments engaged in activities pertaining to crop production and plantation though in the agriculture sector were not covered. Thus primarily cultivators themselves were outside the purview of Economic Census. However, services incidental to crop production or plantation provided/ undertaken by any one individual or a firm or a company by charging fee or rent /compensation e.g. machinery & equipment for tilling/cultivation, preparation of field or sowing harvesting/chaffing, transportation of agriculture goods/ produce, charging for irrigation facilities etc. as their principal activity were included and the establishments engaged in such activities were enumerated.

It may be noted that while the growing of tea, coffee, rubber, tobacco, etc. were not classified as agricultural establishments for the purpose of this census, however, establishments engaged in processing of tea, coffee, tobacco etc. were covered.

#### **Agricultural Broad Activates:**

- 1) Agriculture Activities (Except Crop production & Plantation)
- 2) Live Stock
- 3) Forestry and Logging
- 4) Fishing & Aqua Culture

## **NON-AGRICULTURAL ESTABLISHMENT**

Establishments engaged in activities other than agricultural activities as defined above are termed as non- agricultural establishment.

### **Non-Agricultural Broad Activities:**

- 1) Mining and Quarrying
- 2) Manufacturing
- 3) Electricity, Gas, Steam & Air conditioning
- 4) Water Supply and Sewerage and Waste Management
- 5) Constructions
- 6) Sale, Maintenance and repair of Motor vehicles and Motor cycles
- 7) Wholesale Trade
- 8) Retail Trade
- 9) Transport and Storage
- 10) Accommodation and Food service activities
- 11) Information & Communication
- 12) Financial & Insurance Activities
- 13) Real Estate Activities
- 14) Professional, Scientific & Technical Activities
- 15) Administrative and Support Service Activities
- 16) Education
- 17) Human Health and Social Work Activities
- 18) Arts entertainment, Sports & Amusement and Recreation
- 19) Other Activities

### **Following types of establishments were kept out of census coverage:**

- ❖ Agriculture: Establishments growing perennial and non-perennial crops including plantation crops
- ❖ Government offices: Establishments engaged in public administration covering all Ministries, Departments at Central and State/ UT Govt. level and also local Govt. This includes Courts, Tax Office, Offices of Ministry of Defence (Air Force, Navy and Army), Police, ESIC, EPFO etc. (However, government schools/institutions, colleges, hospitals, hostels/ flats, guest houses, government banks, all public sector undertakings including that of Ministry of Defence other than defence equipment production or sensitive material corporations, undertakings etc. were covered.)
- ❖ Establishments involved in Gambling and betting activities declared illegal by the Government
- ❖ International organizations such as United Nations and its agencies, Foreign Embassies/Consulates etc.

## **HOUSEHOLD**

A household is a group of persons usually living together and taking their meals from a common kitchen. It includes temporary stay-away (those whose total period of absence from household is expected to be less than six months) but excludes temporary visitors and guests (with expected total stay of less than 6 months). There may be a household of persons related by blood or a household of unrelated persons or having a mix of both but satisfying above condition of a household. Example of households having unrelated persons/members are boarding houses, messes, hostels, recue houses, jails, ashrams, etc. These are called 'Institutional Households'.

## **CENSUS HOUSE**

A census house is a building or a part of building having a separate main entrance from the road or common courtyard or staircase, etc., used, or recognized as a separate unit. It may be occupied or vacant. It may be used for residential, commercial or for both purposes.

## **PREMISES**

Premise is census house or part of a Census house occupied by a unit/household. If the activity of the enterprise carried out by a unit /household extends beyond the boundaries of a single house to a group of contiguous houses and in rare cases a group of houses in close proximity, the entire group of houses is regarded as single premise.

## **WORKER**

All persons (including children under 15 years of age) working in an establishment either as owners, members of the household working as co-owner or partner or helping the owner in running the establishment, whether hired or not, besides regular and salaried employees, casual/ daily wage labourers are considered as workers for that establishment. A worker may serve the establishment in any capacity-primary worker or as supervisor. Salespersons appointed by an establishment for selling/marketing its produce or services of apprentices, supporting workers, paid or unpaid are also treated as workers. The owner running the establishment would also be considered as a worker and counted for the purpose.

## **CONCEPTS OF VARIOUS TYPES OF OWNERSHIP**

### **GOVERNMENT/PUBLIC SECTOR UNDERTAKING**

Establishments which are wholly owned/run/managed by Central or State governments, quasi-government institutions, local government bodies like Zila/Gram Panchayat, Zila Parishad, City Corporation, Municipal authorities, autonomous bodies like Central/State/deemed to be Universities, Education boards, and government owned institutions like schools, libraries etc. set up by the government, with 100% funding are usually called Government establishments. Those run with more than 50% share of the government and remaining share coming from other sources will be treated as government/ public sector undertaking.

All establishments which are not treated as Government/ Public sector establishments will be treated as Private Establishments and classified into one of the following:

## **PROPRIETARY ESTABLISHMENT**

When an individual is the sole owner of an establishment it is a proprietary establishment.

## **PARTNERSHIP ESTABLISHMENT**

Partnership is defined as a 'relationship between two or more persons who have agreed to share the profits of a business carried out by all or any one of them acting for all'. There may be two or more owners in a firm, belonging to the same or different household, on a partnership basis, with or without formal registration. All partnership establishments registered under partnership Act, 1932 were also covered in the Economic census.

## **PRIVATE CORPORATE ESTABLISHMENTS (COMPANIES)**

Those Private Establishments (companies) registered under the companies Act 1956 and carrying out economic activities fall under the category of 'Private corporate Establishments'. It includes private limited and public limited companies, as well as establishments registered under Limited liability partnership ACT, 2008.

## **NON-PROFIT INSTITUTION**

Non-Profit Institution are legal or social entities created for the purpose of producing goods and services whose status does not permit them to be a source of income/profit or other financial gain for the units that establish, control or finance them.

## **CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES**

A co-operative society is one that is formed through the co-operation of a number of persons, recognized as members of the society, to benefit themselves. In the process, the funds are raised by members' contribution /investments and the profits generated out of the society's activities are shared by the members. Such societies are usually registered under Co-operative Societies Act 1912.

## **SELF-HELP GROUPS (SHG)**

A self-help group (SHG) is a financial intermediary usually composed of 10-20 local persons. Members make small regular savings/ contributions over a few months until there is enough capital in the group to begin lending. Funds are then lent back to the members or to others in the village for any purpose. Many SHGs are 'linked' to banks for the delivery of microcredit. SHG need not be registered.

## **NATURE OF OPERATION**

If the entrepreneurial activity is carried on or likely to be carried on (for newly started establishments) throughout the year more or less regularly, it is treated as perennial activity. If the activity of the establishment is confined to a particular season i.e. fixed months of a year, the same is called the seasonal activity. The economic activity of the establishment which is neither perennial nor seasonal is termed as casual. In case of casual entrepreneurial activity, it is carried out occasionally depending upon the availability of time and resources.

## **NUMBER OF PERSONS EMPLOYED ON THE LAST WORKING DAY IN RELATION TO DAY OF VISIT**

The number of persons found working comprising, hired, non-hired (including family members; unpaid apprentice and owner himself), on the last working day in the establishment with gender break up: male and female, and the total had been recorded. Eunuchs & Hermaphrodite workers are added under male. Regular wage/salaried workers, who are temporarily absent on the last working day were also counted. In case of working owners/other family workers (i.e. Self-employed persons), those 'normally 'work in the establishment but could not work on the last working day, were also included.



## CHAPTER THREE

### STATE RESULTS AT A GLANCE

This chapter is devoted to the analysis of the main findings of the Sixth Economic Census held in Delhi during the year 2013. District level data on various parameters of Sixth Economic Census with detail analytical note has already been presented in the public domain through our publication "*Report on Sixth Economic Census, Delhi*" during February, 2016. The data were collected in respect of 112 villages and 113 towns (MCD, NDMC and Delhi Cantonment and 110 Census towns) as per frame provided by Census 2011 frame as received from Office of the Registrar General, India. Initially, the data on various economic indicators was got tabulated on the basis of 11 districts of Delhi. In the earlier Economic Census the NCT of Delhi was divided into 9 districts but in 6<sup>th</sup> Economic Census the number of districts increased to 11 and data was collected on the basis of these 11 districts. All the entrepreneurial units were grouped under the broad sectors of economy, namely, agriculture (other than crop production and plantation), non-agriculture (other than service), non-agriculture (service). The importance of non-agricultural sector gets multiplied in respect of NCT of Delhi as this set of activities occupy pivotal position as 99.2% of establishments come under this category.

The data reveals that there was 15.52% growth in terms of number of establishments over the Fifth Economic Census from 7,57,743 in 2005 (5th EC) to 8,75,308 in 2013 (6th EC).

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS**

The results reveal that the total number of establishments found to be operating in the geographical boundaries of NCT of Delhi during 2013 arrived at 8,75,308. Break-up of establishments in terms of agricultural and non-agricultural type revealed that 7,008 (0.80%) belong to former category and 8,68,300 (99.20%) to latter.

Establishments can be classified into two broad categories on the basis of nature of employment viz. Own-account establishments (OAEs) operated without hired worker and establishments (H) run with at least one hired worker. Out of the total establishments, 4,77,498 (54.55%) were OAEs and 3,97,810 (45.45%) were establishments (H).

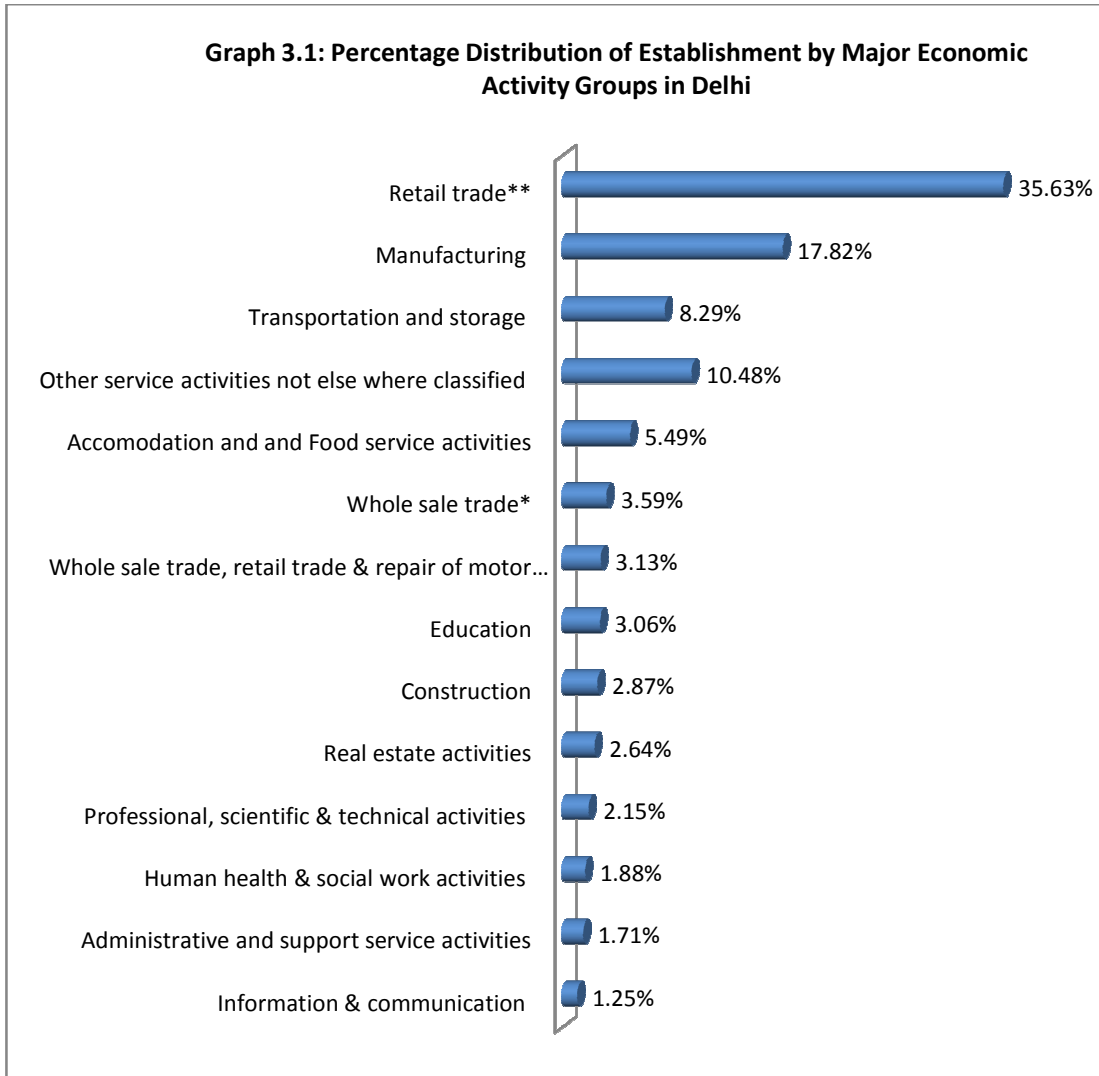

Sector and establishment type-wise distribution of establishment by major economic activity groups is presented in Statement 3.2. At the state level, economic activities in field of 'Trade', 'Manufacturing', and 'Transportation' emerged as the main major economic activities with the largest number of establishments (68.46%).

### **ESTABLISHMENT BY SIZE OF EMPLOYMENT**

The distribution of establishments by major economic activity groups by their employment size class reveals that 89.97% of establishments were of employment size class 1- 5, followed by 6.53% of size class 6 –9, 3.32% of size class 10-99 and the rest 0.17% were of employment size class of 100 & above.

Out of 7,87,491 establishments of employment size class 1-5, Retail Trade activity is having the maximum share of 38.32% followed by 'Manufacturing' 14.78%. 'Manufacturing' accounts for 38.39% of establishments having employment size class of 100 & above followed by 'Professional, scientific & Professional activities' 9.76%. The details are given in Statement 3.3.

## ESTABLISHMENTS BY NATURE OF OPERATION, STRUCTURE & LOCATION

The number of establishments by their structure and nature of operations indicates that in agricultural sector, 97.22% were perennial, 2.14 % were seasonal and 0.64% were working on casual basis. Under the Non Agriculture Sector 97.10% were perennial, 2.16% were seasonal and 0.74% were working on casual basis. For combined agricultural and non-agricultural establishments, 97.10% were perennial, 2.16% were seasonal and 0.74 % were working on casual basis. The statement 3.4 shows that maximum numbers of establishments engaged under different activities in Delhi were doing their business on regular basis.

As per this Statement 53.71% establishments were situated outside the Household with fixed structure, 21.67% were outside household without any fixed structure and the remaining 24.62% were running their business within the household.

## EMPLOYMENT

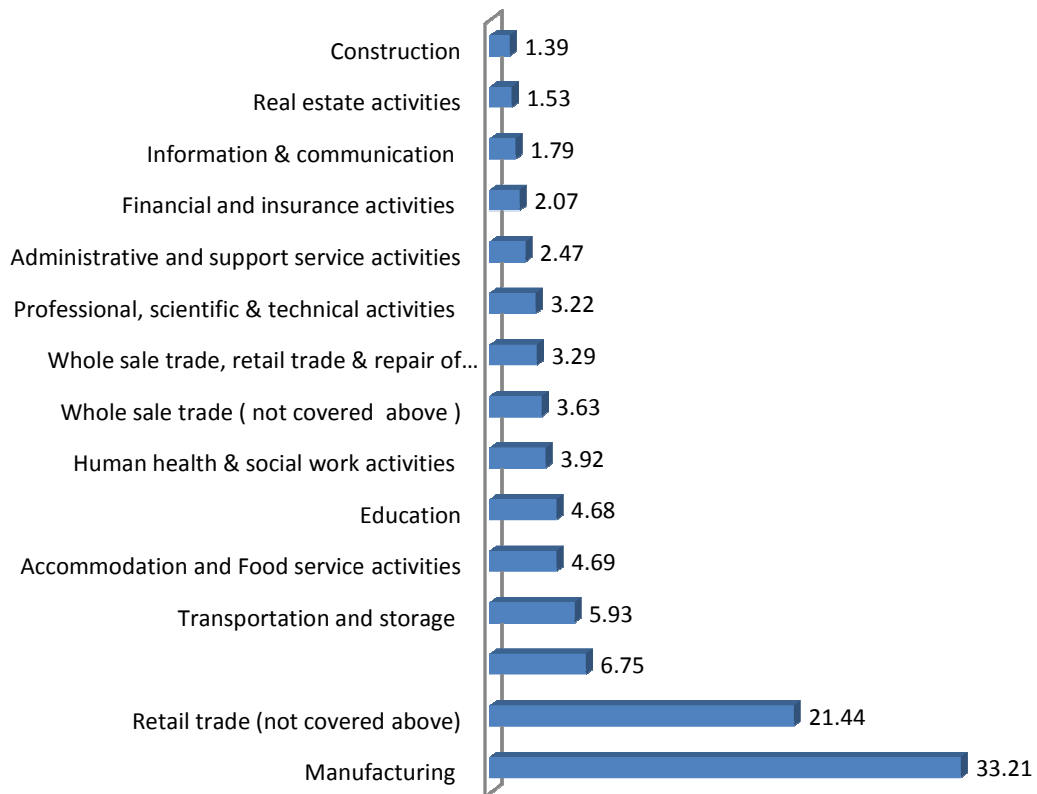
The number of persons employed by type of establishment indicates that 30,19,781 persons were employed in 8,75,308 establishments with an average of employee 3.45 per establishment. In the context of type of establishment 19.72% of workers were working in the establishments with no hired worker i.e. in OAE. Remaining 80.28% were working in establishments with at least one hired worker. In the establishments (H) persons per establishment is worked out to 6.09 as against 1.25 in the case of OAE.

Sector and establishment type-wise distribution of employment by major economic activity groups is presented in Statement 3.5. At the state level, economic activities in field of 'Trade', 'Manufacturing', and 'Transportation' emerged as the main major economic activities with the largest number of employment (67.50%).

## CHAPTER FOUR

### PROFILE OF LOCAL BODIES

This chapter is devoted to the analysis of the main findings of the Sixth Economic Census held in Delhi during the year 2013, disaggregated up to Local Body level. In this report, special focus has been given to the distribution of economic activities among five local bodies, namely, North MCD, East MCD and south MCD, New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) and Delhi cantonment Board. Due to the growing demand of data at local body level from different sources, efforts have been initiated to get the data of various economic indicators tabulated at LB and ward level. The wards of MCD have been distributed among three LBs, namely, North, East and South MCDs as per available information provided in the official website of MCDs.

#### DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS

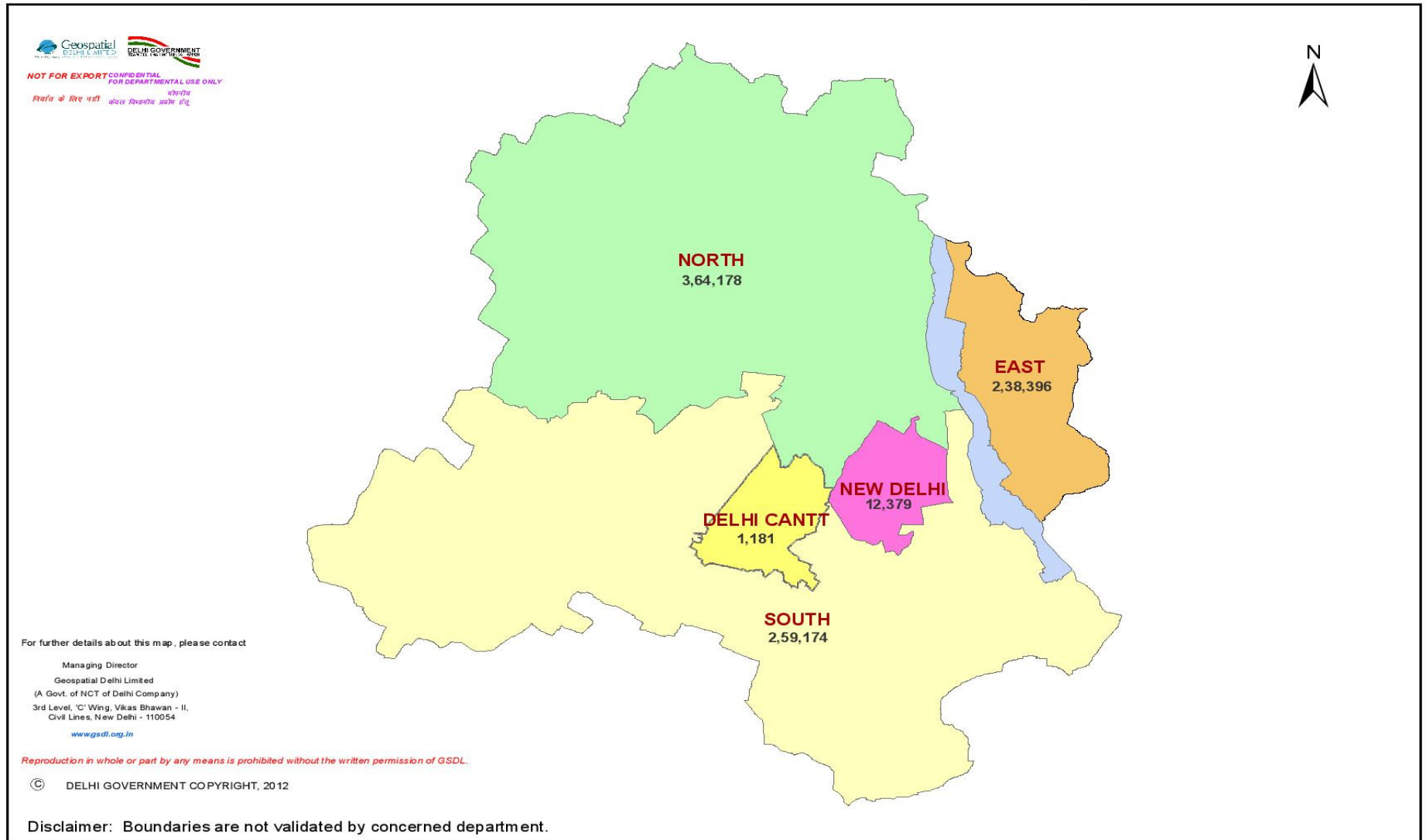
As indicated earlier that establishments are classified into two broad categories on the basis of the nature of employment, namely, Own-account establishments (OAEs) operated without hired worker and Establishment (H) run with at least one hired worker. It has already been mentioned that, out of 8.75 lacs of establishments registered in Delhi, 54.6% were OAEs and 45.4% were Establishments (H). Statement-4.1 shows the distribution of establishments among five local bodies, i.e. MCD North, MCD East, MCD South, NDMC and Delhi Cantonment Board.

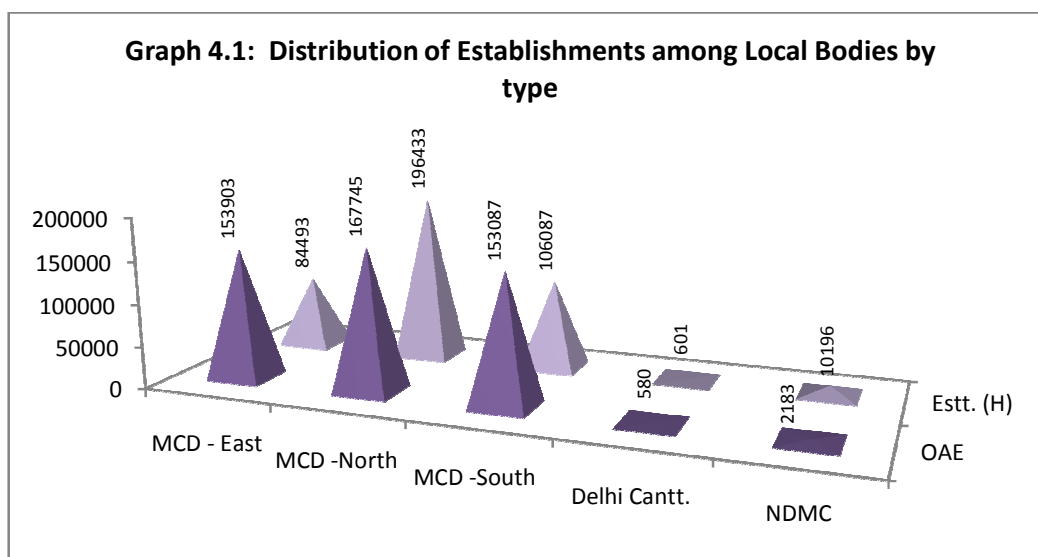
Among the local bodies, MCD North excels with the highest number of enterprises, i.e. 3.64 lacs (41.6% of total), followed by MCD South with 2.59 lacs (29.6%) and MCD East with 2.38 lacs (27.2%). However, if we analyse the concentration of establishments per lac of population, MCD East shows the highest concentration with 6,045 establishments per lac of population, followed by MCD North with 5,822 establishments per lac population. Delhi Cantonment has the lowest concentration of 1,070 establishments per lac of population for obvious reason. Ward-wise distribution of establishments is given in Table-1 of Annexure-I.

## DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS AMONG LOCAL BODIES, DELHI





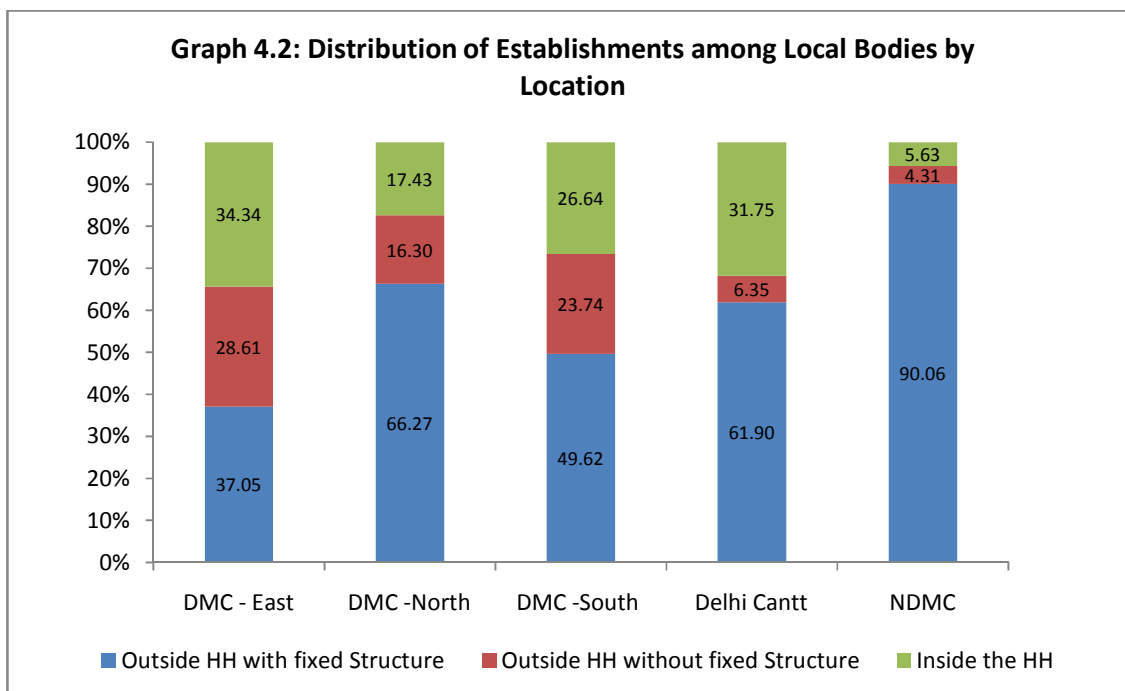
### ESTABLISHMENTS BY THEIR LOCATION

Establishments are further categorized in three groups by their location. Some of the establishments are operated outside the households with fixed structure; some of them are operated inside the household whereas a large number of establishments are run outside the household without any structure. Some examples of third category are vending of ice-cream, selling of vegetables in *hut*, *mandis*, footpath etc., pulling of rickshaw, vending of news paper etc.

The statement- 4.2 reveals that proportion of establishments located outside the household with fixed structure was maximum in NDMC (90%), followed by Delhi Cantt. (62%) and MCD North (66%). Proportion of establishments operated from the household was the highest in MCD East (34%), followed by Delhi Cantt. (32%) and MCD South (27%). Around 29% of establishments were run outside the household without any structure in MCD East and 24% in MCD South.

#### ESTABLISHMENTS BY NATURE OF OPERATIONS

Establishments according to nature of operations fall under three categories viz perennial, seasonal and casual. Statement-4.3 depicts the number of establishments by their nature of operations i.e. perennial, seasonal and casual. As in the case of Delhi as a whole, same trend has been observed in all local bodies. All the LBs are showing number of perennial establishments by more than 96%.

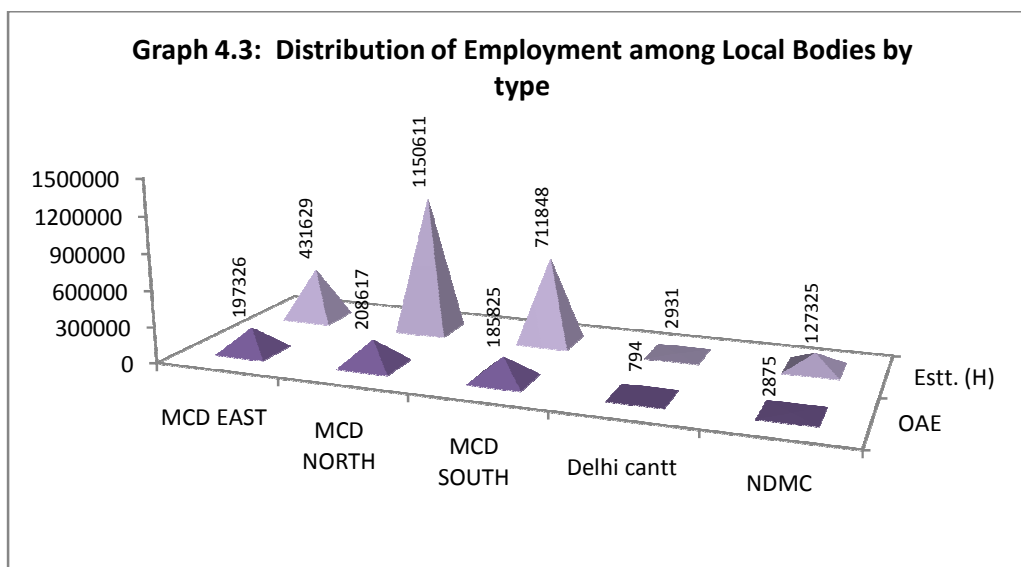

## EMPLOYMENT

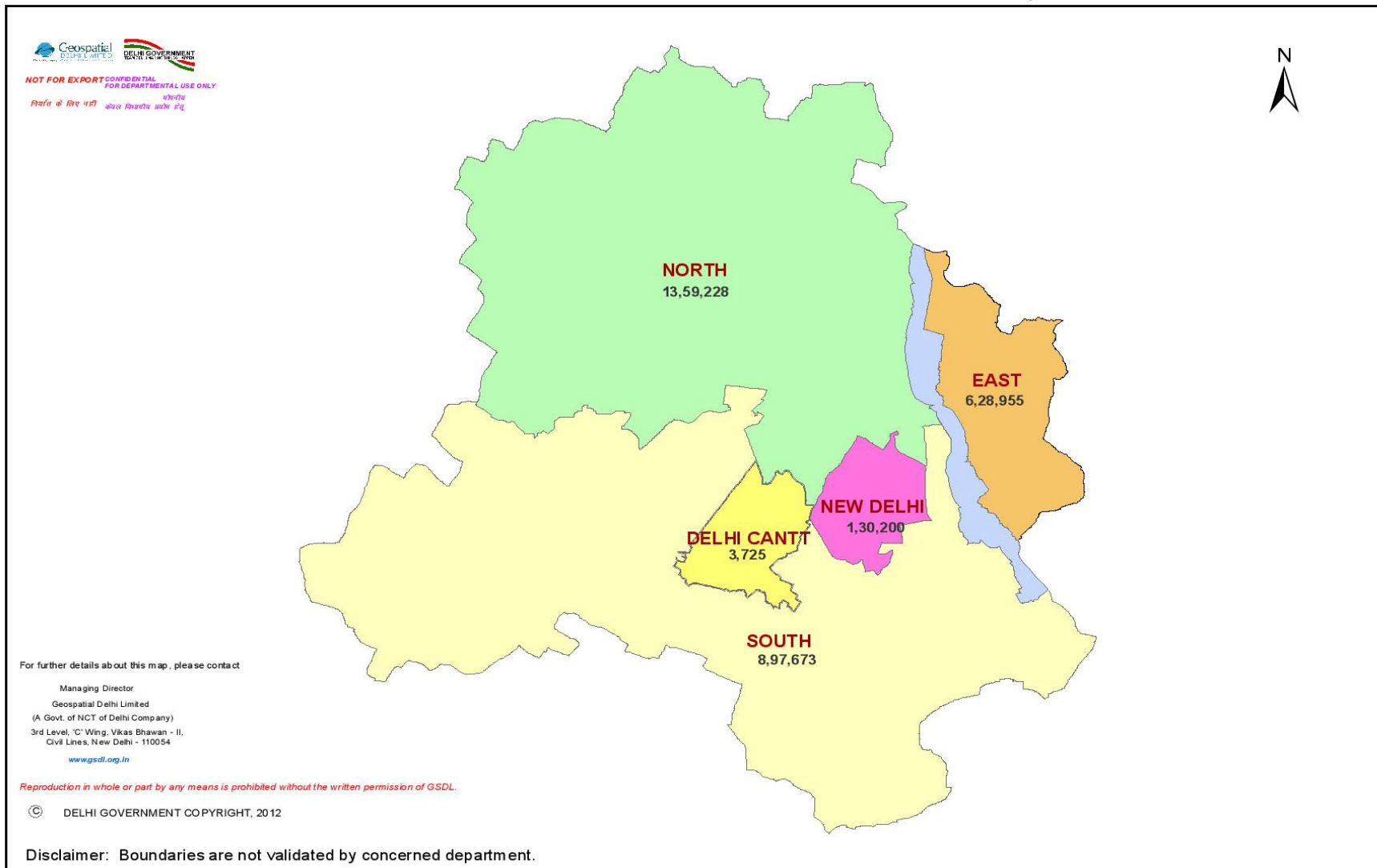
The numbers of persons employed by the type of establishment among different local bodies are presented in statement-4.4. As already indicated in chapter-three, 30.2 lacs of persons were engaged 8.75 lacs of establishments with an average of employee 3.45 per establishment. The highest numbers of persons were employed in North MCD with 13.6 lacs person employed, followed by 8.98 lacs in South MCD and 6.29 lacs in East MCD. Comparative analysis depicts that in the context of number of persons per establishment, New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) with 10.5 workers per establishment, outdoes all the local bodies of Delhi.

## ESTABLISHMENTS BY EMPLOYMENT SIZE CLASS

From the statement-4.5 it is evident that maximum of establishments were coming under size class of employment of 1-5 for all the local Bodies and State as a whole. Number of establishments decreases with increase of employment size. Proportion of small establishments (with size 1-5) were maximum in MCD East (91.98%), closely followed by MCD South (91%). Bigger establishments with employment size 50 & more constituted only 0.64 % of total establishments of Delhi. Most of the big establishments were concentrated in MCD North and MCD South. The highest number of establishment with workers 50 & more is exhibited in MCD North (2,753) , followed by MCD South ( 1,780) .

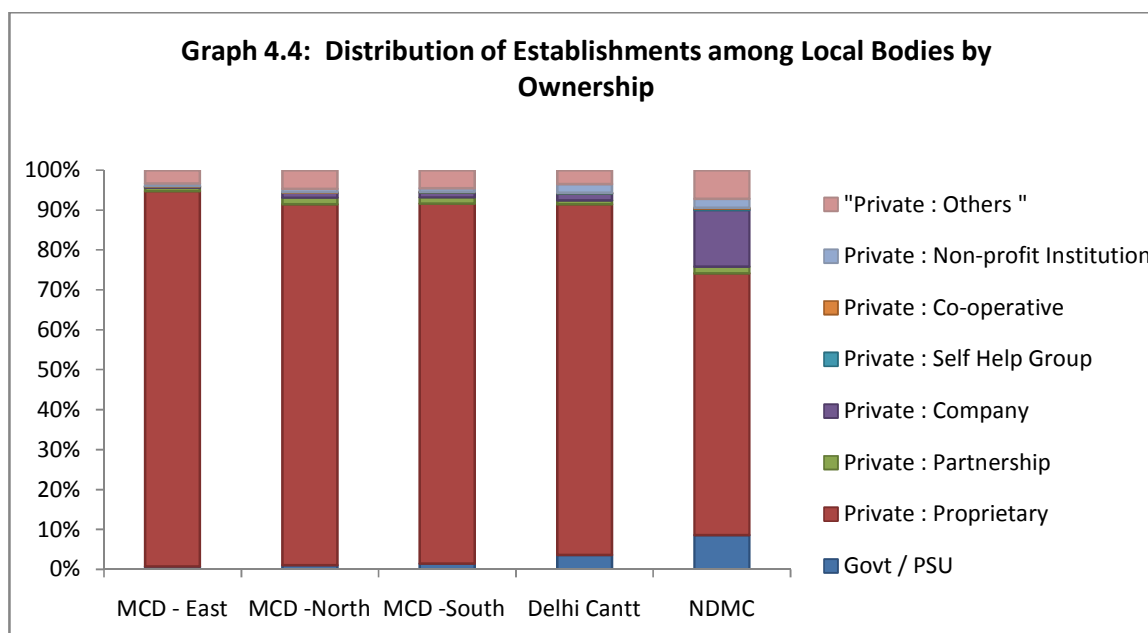

## ESTABLISHMENTS BY OWNERSHIP

In Delhi most of the establishments were proprietary in nature. Statement-4.6 shows the distribution of establishments among local bodies by the ownership. The statement reveals that a 94% of establishments were proprietary in MCD East, higher by 3 percentage points than the state average of 91 %. In Delhi only 1.23 % of establishment were owned by Government and PSU. A maximum of 8.63% of Govt/PSU establishments were reported in New Delhi Municipal Council. In absolute terms, North MCD was having the highest number of Companies (3,229), followed by NDMC (1,759).

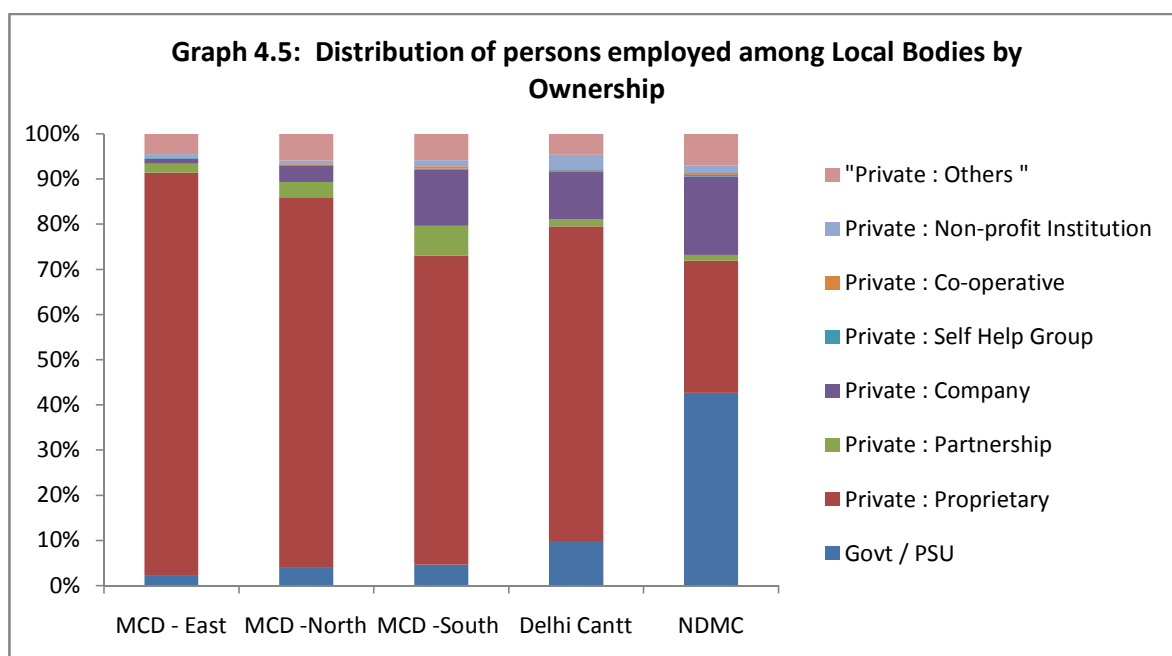


77% of total persons engaged in economic activities, were working under proprietary establishments. Among the local bodies, proportion of workers employed in proprietary establishments was the highest in East MCD with 89.3%, closely followed by MCD North with 82.05%. Interestingly, 42.66% of total persons employed were working in Govt./ PSU in NDMC with average employment of 52 persons per establishment. Similarly, for the ownership type Company al NDMC again exhibit the highest proportion of persons employed with 17.38%. In companies the average employment per establishment was returned as 12.86 in NDMC.

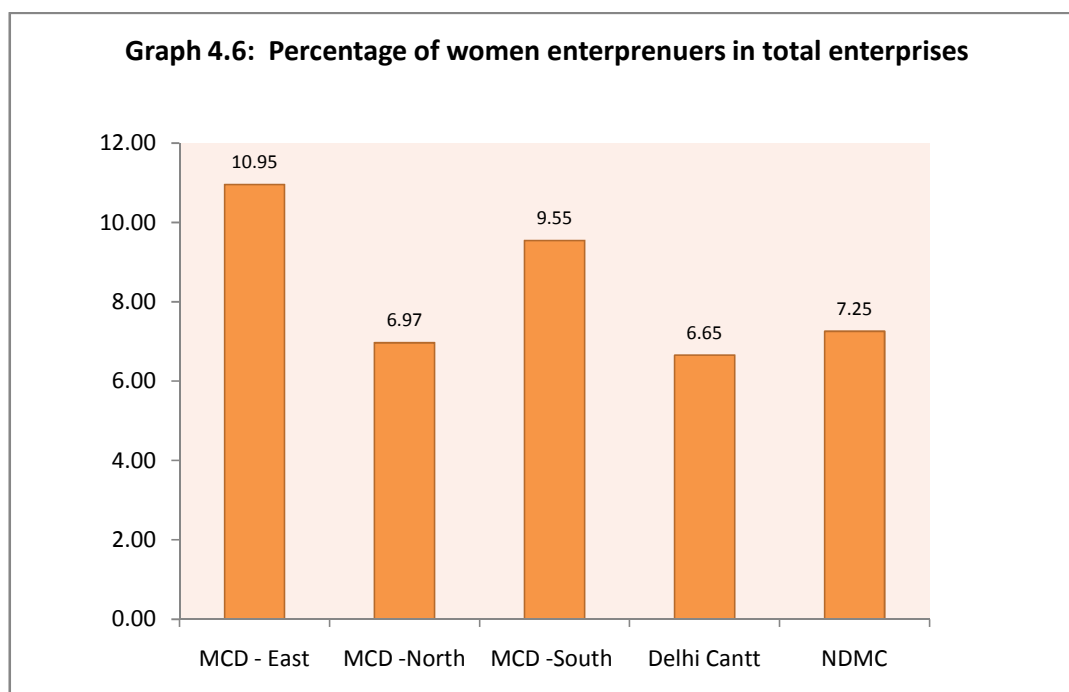


**WOMEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN DELHI**

Statement-4.8 shows the distribution of proprietary establishments by the gender of the owners. Among the 8,75,308 establishments, 90.94% were proprietary establishments. Further, 8.85% of total proprietary establishments were running under female entrepreneurship in Delhi. The statement-4.9 depicts the distribution of establishments under female entrepreneurship with all female workers at the level of local bodies in Delhi. 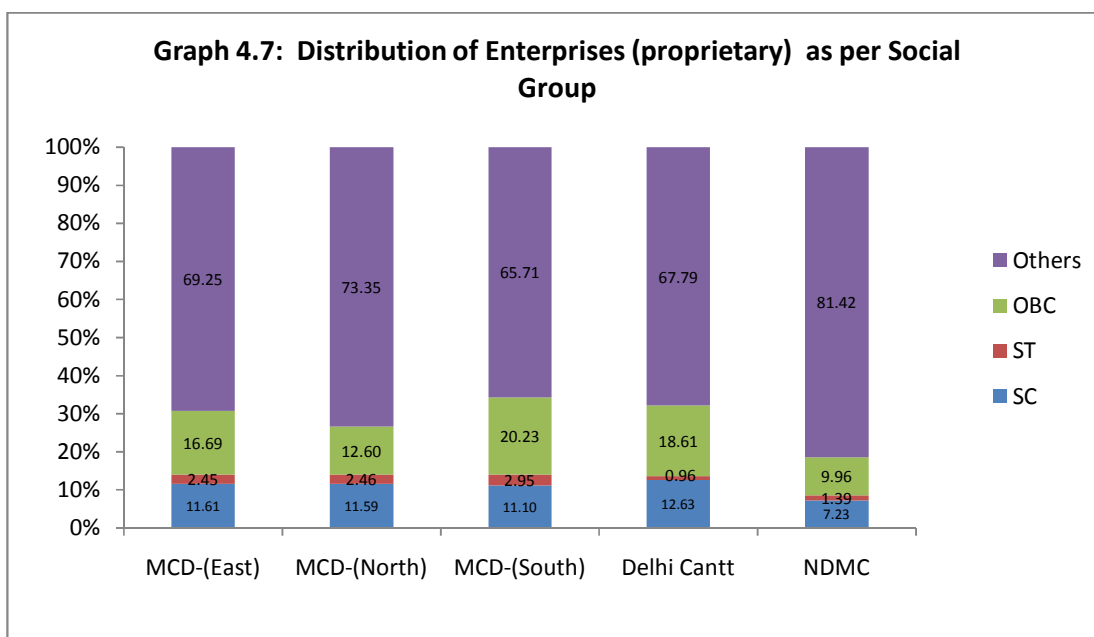

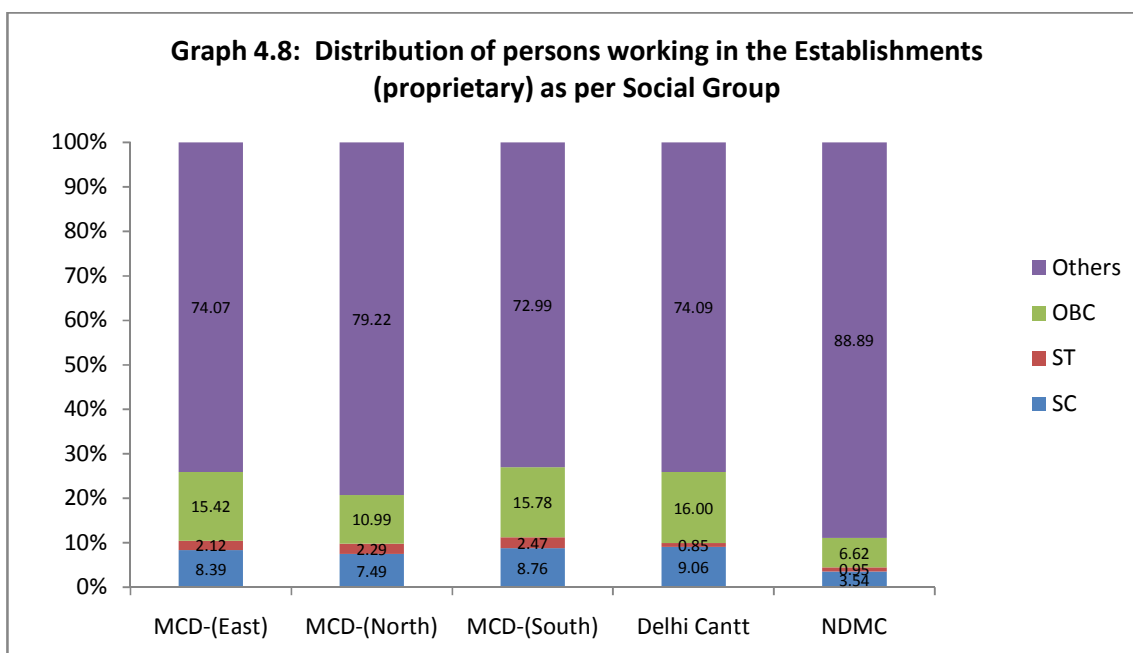

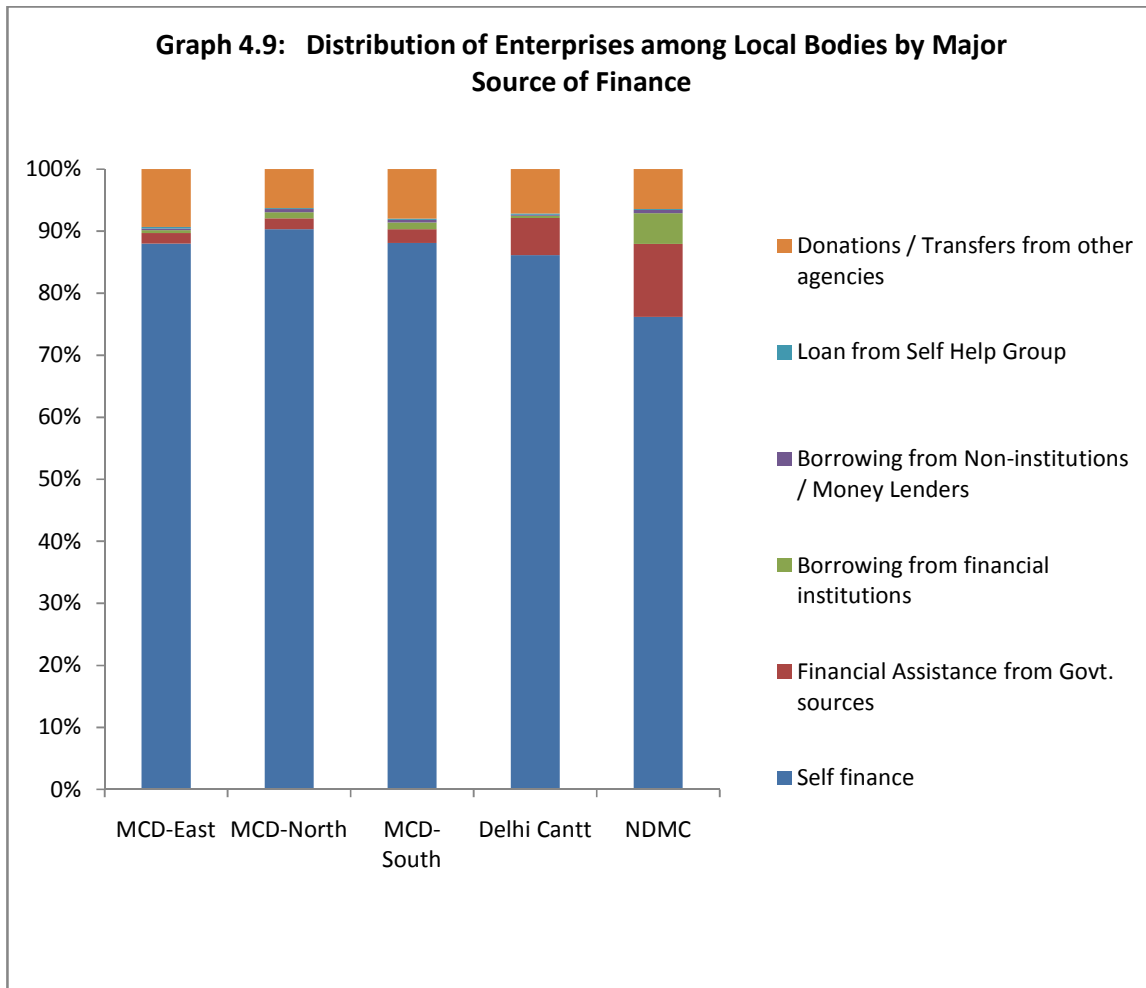
