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## **INTRODUCTION**

Prices affect all sections of society and as such price statistics are regarded as the most important economic data which influence/reflect the changes in economic activities. The changes in prices can be measured both in absolute and economic terms. The changes in prices over a period of time can be gauged by the statistical device of Index Numbers of prices.

Price indices are used as an instrument to measure the relative changes in the level of economic activities of a specified group / place with pre-determined purposes. Wholesale prices are mainly used to estimate rate of inflation in the economy, while consumer price index measures the effect of prices on item basket affecting the living of a specified group of families. These price indices are the only instrument to measure the wages and salaries of specified categories of people in real terms (i.e. with respect of prices prevailed in the specified base year). In the economic analysis price indices are commonly used as inflator or deflator as per the requirement of the study.

## **TYPES OF INDICES COMPILED**

Following price indices are being compiled:

1. Consumer Price Index for industrial Workers
2. Consumer Price Index for Rural, Urban & Combined
3. Whole Sale Price Index

## **DATA SOURCES**

- (1) Consumer Price Index for Industrial workers is being compiled by Labour Bureau, Shimla. This Index is compiled for 78 different centers in India. Each centre has been assigned a weight at all India level and accordingly C.P.I. at all India level is also being compiled.
- (2) Consumer Price Index for Rural, Urban & combined is compiled by CSO, MOSPI, Govt. of India. This index is compiled for 310 town & 1181 villages in India. Weighting diagrams (consumption patterns) of the CPI have derived from the results of the NSS 61<sup>st</sup> round of Consumer Expenditure Survey (2004-05). The base year for this index is 2010=100.
- (3) Wholesale price index is being compiled by Economic Advisor, Ministry of Industries, Govt. of India. This Index is being compiled at all India level.

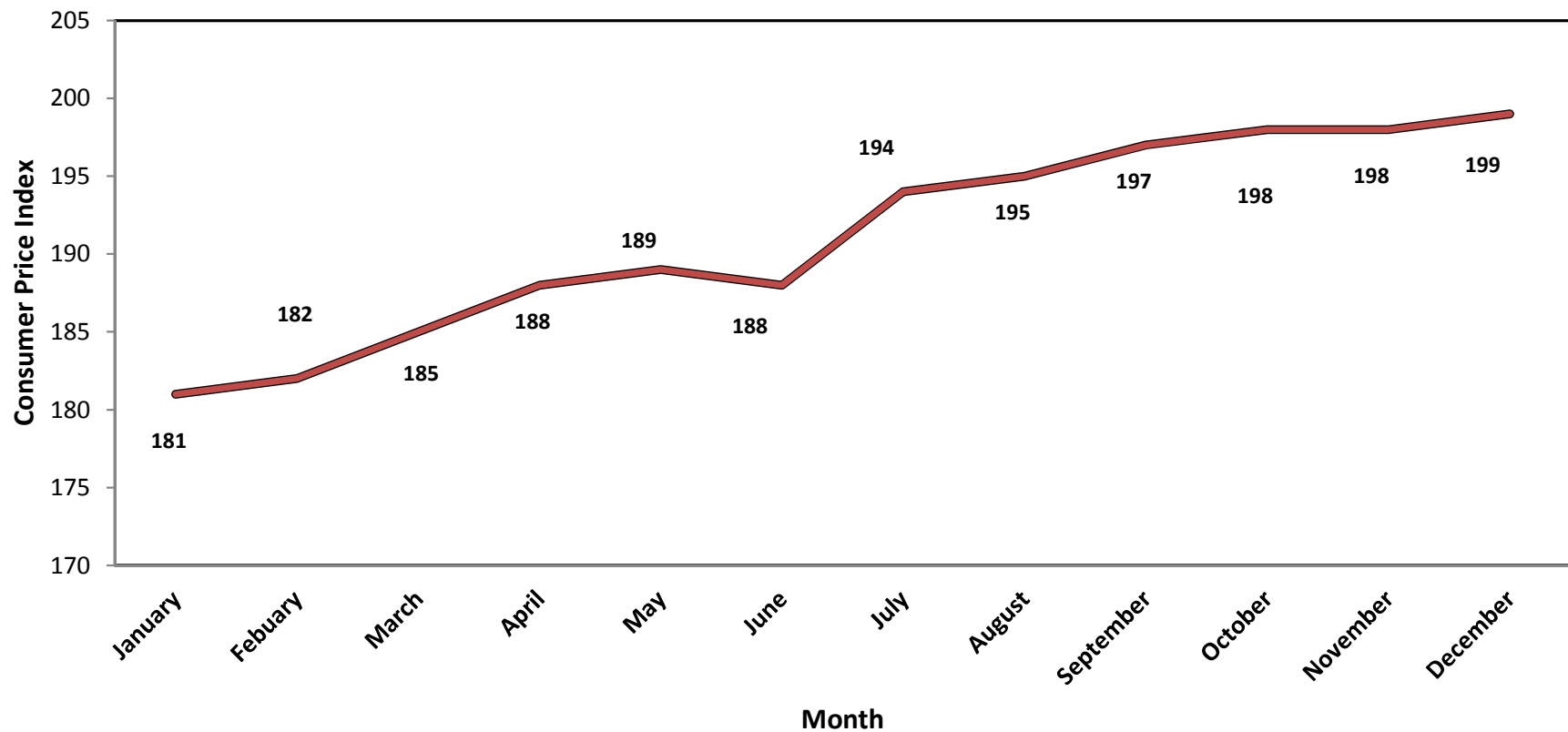
## **PURPOSE**

In this report the index of all above mentioned indices are for the last ten years presented at all India level as well as State level. The weight assigned to each centre in every index is also incorporated. The report has been prepared with a view that different types of indices could be available at one place. The report also provides time series data to evaluate price trend.

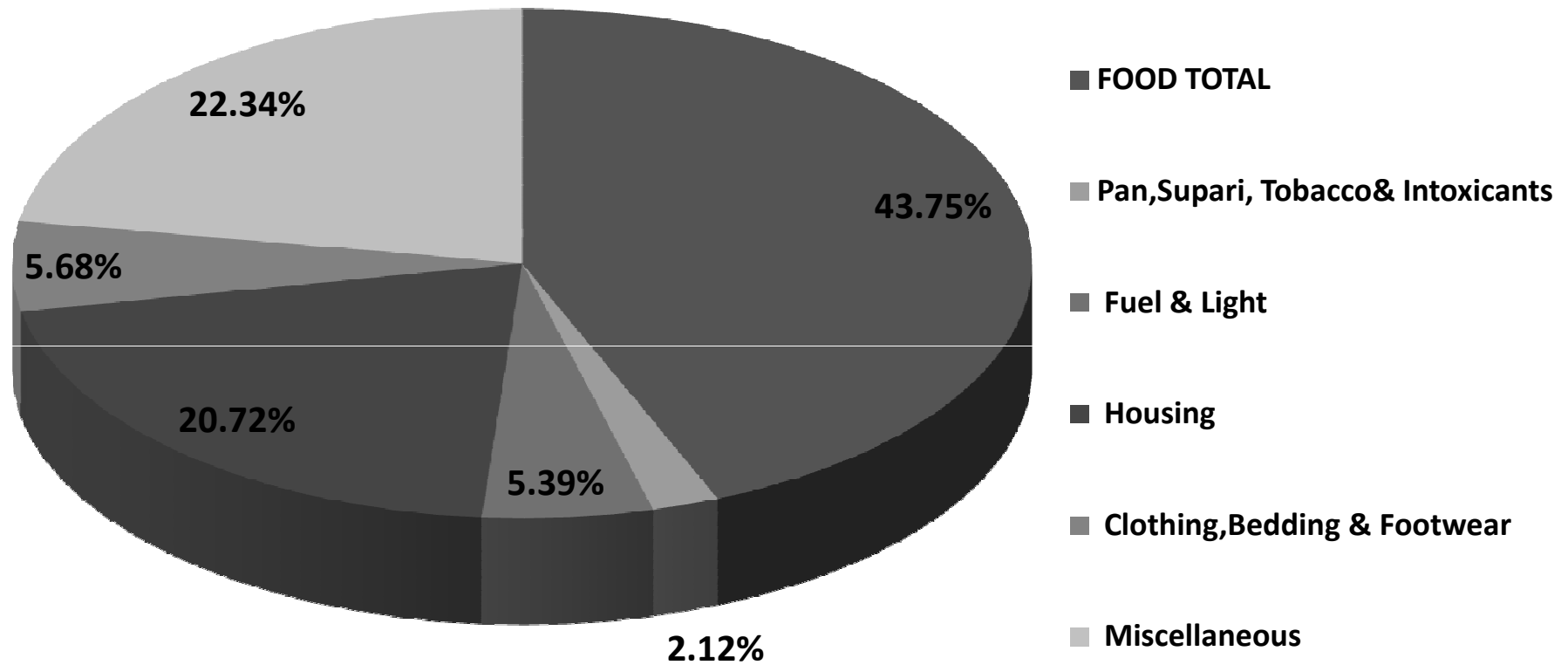

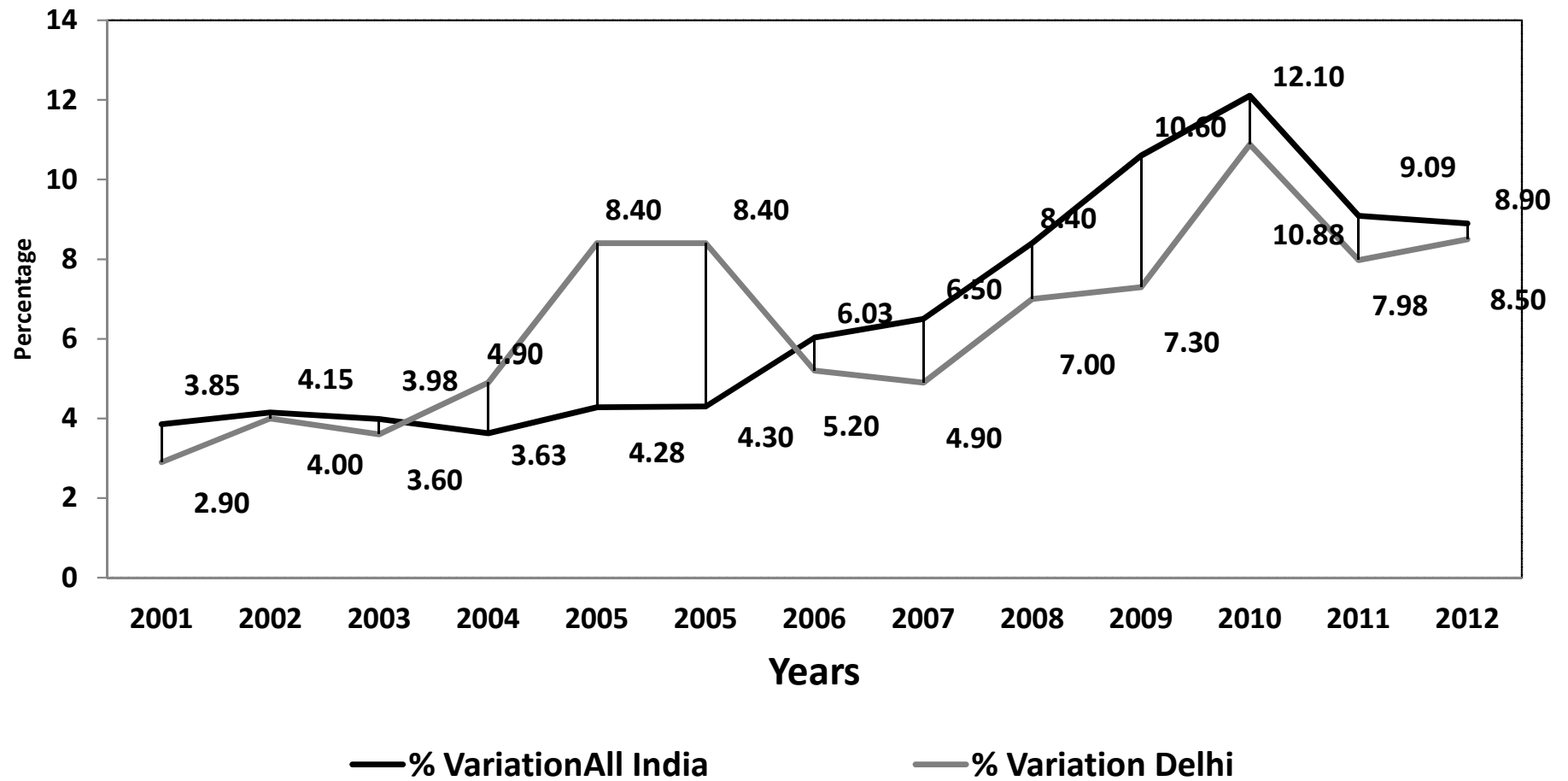

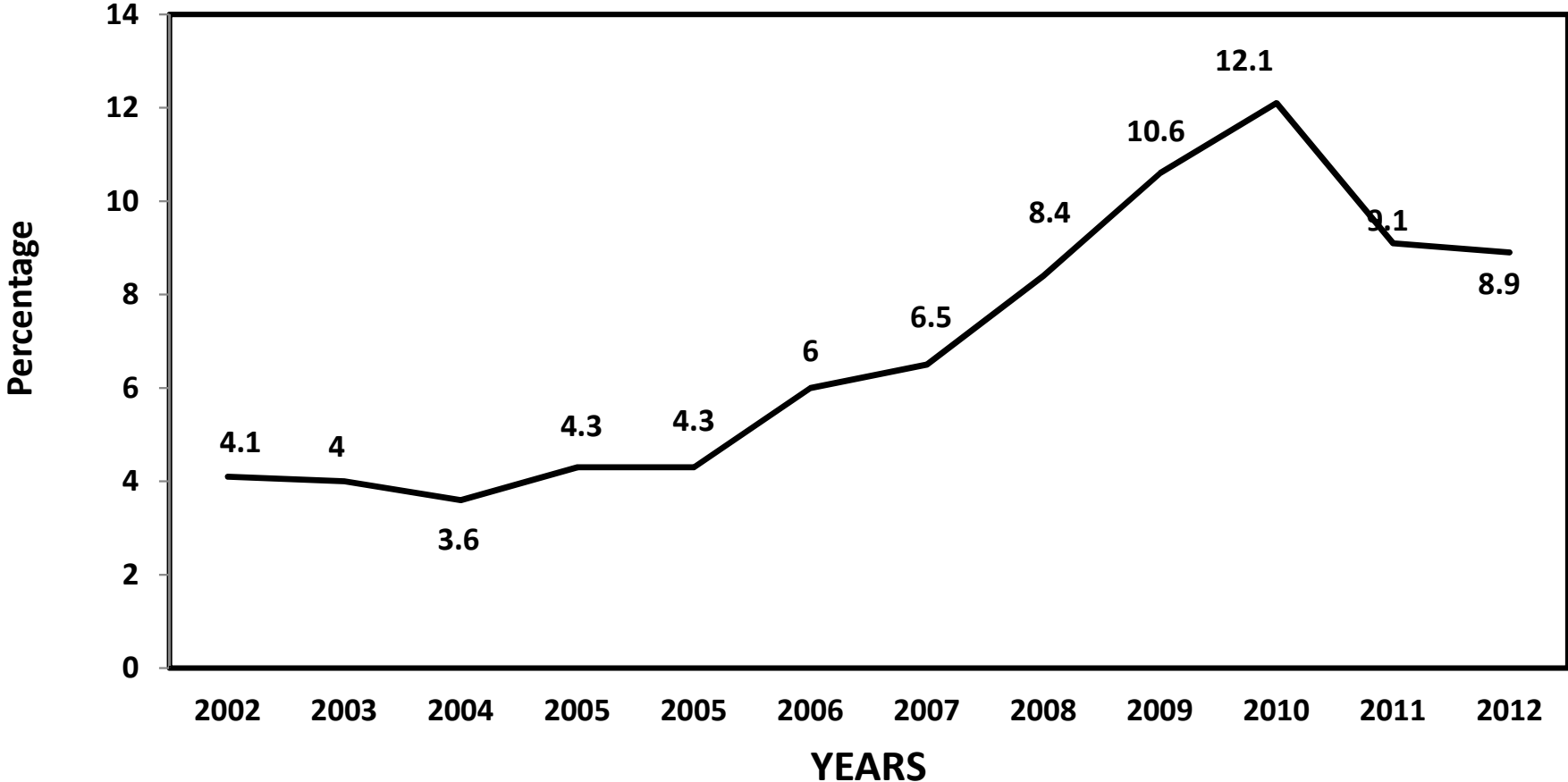
