### निगम स्कूलों के लिए दोगुना बजट मांगा

नई दिल्ली। दक्षिणी दिल्ली नगर निगम ने दिल्ली सरकार से अपने स्कूलों के लिए दोगुना बजट जारी करने की मांग की है। इस आशय का प्रस्ताव भी निगम की स्थायी समिति बैठक में मंगलवार को पारित किया गया। बैठक में कहा गया कि अपना बजट पेश करते हुए दिल्ली सरकार ने शिक्षा के बजट को दोगुना करने की बात कही। इसलिए अब निगम स्कूलों का बजट भी सरकार की दोगुना करना चाहिए। दक्षिणी निगम लगभग पांच सौ स्कूलों का संचालन करता है। इसमें तीन लाख से ज्यादा बच्चे पढ़ते हैं। स्थायी समिति ने शिक्षा के बजट में कटौती नहीं करने और उसे दोगुना करने की मांग प्रस्ताव के जिरए की।

#### 2012-13 में दिल्ली में रोजगार के मौके बढे

नई दिल्ली। 2012-13 में बीते वर्ष की तुलना में रोजगार के मौके बढ़े हैं। दिल्ली सरकार की रिपोर्ट के मुताबिक 2011-12 में दिल्ली में 1.19 कर्मचारी फैक्टरी में काम करते थे लेकिन 2012-13 में यह संख्या बढ़कर 1.26 लाख तक पहुंच गई है।

## Delhi factory output rises by 13 per cent

THE OUTPUT of 3,183 working factories in Delhi increased by 13.7 per cent between 2011-12 and 2012-13, according to the report on annual survey of industries (ASI) in the year 2012-13.

The output of the working factories increased from Rs 50,900 crore to Rs 57,858 crore, stated the report, which was released by deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia Tuesday.

The number of employees in factories also increased from 1.19 lakh to 1.26 lakh in 2012-13. Out of 3,183 working factories, in 1426 factories, the number of workers in each factory was 100 or above, while in 204 factories the number of workers was 500 and above, the report stated.

Sisodia said the maximum number of factories, 527, were engaged in textile and apparel manufacturing, followed by 306 in wholesale and retail trade and repairing of motor vehicles.

According to the ASI report, six out of nine districts in Delhi registered a decline in the number of factories as compared to 2011-12. However, south and west districts witnessed an increase in the number of factories by 19.1 per cent and 11.4 per cent.

"As a whole; Delhi shows a growth of 6.55 per cent in the number of workers as compared to 2011-12. Highly industrialised districts, namely, south, west and north-west districts show an increase in the number of workers — 12.7 per cent, 7.2 per cent and 4.3 per cent, respectively.

Three districts out of nine have shown decrease in number of workers. These three districts are north (-18.4%), north east (-23.9%), east (-30.5%)," the ASI stated.

The National Capital saw around 13.7 per cent growth in its factory output, which employs around 1.26 lakh workers, mostly in the areas of leather, textile and apparel manufacturing, wholesale and retail trade among others in the 2012-13.

The report on 'Annual Survey of Industries', released by Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia who says that the number of working factories have also increased from 2,976 in 2011-12 to 3,183

in 2012-13.

With a rise in their number, total number of employees working in these factories increased from 1.19 lakh to 1.26 lakh in the same period. paid to these employees increased from ₹2,260 crore to ₹2,577 crore. And in 1,426 out of all the factories the number of workers are above 100. In 204 factories the number of workers are 500 and above," the report says.

The report, prepared by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics of the Government, reveals that the most number of factories, 940, are located in the south district, closely followed by the northwest district which has 912. Among the rest, 829 factories are located in the west District, 205 and 98 in East and Central districts respectively.

In the three most industrialised districts namely, south, north-west and west share of total fixed capital, total invested capital and total working capital are 92.69 percent, 93.27 per cent and 82.70 per cent respectively. Invested Capital per unit and Productive capital per unit are the highest in the North-West District.

Productive Capital per unit are returned as 1237.29 lakh and 996.80 lakh respectively in this district.

"Out of 3183 working factories, about 1022 came into existence in Delhi after the year 2010 and 134 after the year 2011. Moreover, 27 factories established before the year 1950 are still in operation. About 1266 factories are classified as Private Limited Companies, 1055 are under Individual Proprietorship and 775 are under Partnership," the report adds. The value of input material used in these factories increased from Rs 43,949 crore in 2011-12 to 49,024 crore in 2012-13. The output - input ratio stands at 1.18 while the value added output ratio is at 0.14.

# City's factory output increases by 13.7%

3,183 Units Employ Nearly 1.26L Workers

New Delhi: Delhi witnessed a 13.7% growth in its factory output in 2012-13. There were around 1.26 lakh workers, mostly engaged in the areas of leather, textile and apparel manufacturing as well as repairing of vehicles during this period.

Of 3,183 factories, 1,022 came into existence after 2000 and 134 after 2011. About 1,266 factories are classified as private limited companies, 1,055 are under individual proprietorship and 775 are under partnership, said deputy CM Manish Sisodia while releasing areport on Annual Survey of Industries 2012-13 on Tuesday.

The total output of 3,183 factories increased from Rs 50,900 crore in 2011-12 to Rs 57, 858 crore in 2012-13. The value of input material used in these factories increased from Rs 43,949 crore in 2011-12 to Rs 49,024 crore in 2012-13.

"The total emoluments paid to these employees increased from Rs 2,260 crore to Rs 2,577 crore," says the report prepared by the directorate of economics & statistics of the Delhi government.

The average emoluments per employee working in the registered factories were a mere Rs 2.04 lakh, just about Rs 17,000 a month. The data also shows that even those work-

ing in the organized sector are earning less than Rs 20,000 a month. The district-wise average shows that the all-inclusive package lacks uniformity.

For instance, the highest annual emoluments were recorded in Central district where it was Rs 5.58 lakh per annum followed by Rs 2.87 lakh in Southwest district, Rs 2.20 lakh in East district and Rs 2.03 lakh in West district.

North district recorded the lowest income of Rs 1.59 lakh per annum.

The report reveals that in 1,426 factories, the number of workers in each factory is 100 or above. In 204 factories, the number of workers is 500 and above. Sisodia said the total number of employees working in these factories increased from 1.19 lakhs in 2011-12 to 1.26 lakhs in 2012-13.

उपमुख्यमंत्री मनीष सिसोदिया हारा मंगलवार को जारी 2012-13 की औद्योगिक वार्षिक रिपोर्ट (एएसआइ) के अनुसार दिल्ली में वर्ष 2011-12 में कुल पंजीकृत फैक्ट्रियों की संख्या 2,976 थी, जबिक 2012-13 में बढ़कर 3,183 हो गई। रिपोर्ट के अनुसार वर्ष 2011-12 में तमाम फैक्ट्रियों में पंजीकृत कामगारों की कुल संख्या 1.19 लाख थी, जो वर्ष 2012-13 में 1.26 लाख हो गई। रिपोर्ट में बताया गया कि कामगारों को वेतन आदि पर कुल 2260 करोड़ रुपया फैक्ट्री मालिक देते है।

कुल 3183 फैक्ट्रयों में से 1426 फैक्ट्रयां ऐसी हैं, जहां कर्मचारियों की संख्या 100 से अधिक है। 204 फैक्ट्रियों में कर्मचारियों की तादात 500 से भी अधिक है। दिल्ली में सर्वाधिक 527 पंजीकृत फैक्ट्रियों में कपड़ा व रेडीमेड वस्त्र बनाए जाते है। 306 फैक्ट्रियों में होलसेल से संबंधित काम होता है।
